

President Notes

Attention all club and prospective members,

The August meeting has also been cancelled due to the uptick of the Covid-19 virus and hopefully will resume in September. We will continue to follow the same procedures in place for the past three months.

Please mail in your entry fees to Lori. As she receives the check, she notes the order they arrive and that is the order we draw for numbers the morning of the tournament. Please note there is a change to encourage members to get their entry in early consistent with our meeting sign ups. Any payment made at the ramp will cause your boat number to be added to the end of the drawn list. The only difference is that we waive the \$5 late entry until the meetings resume.

We will draw numbers at the ramp first thing on our arrival and you will know as you launch what your boat number is. As an example, say there are 20 pre-paid entries, the last known boat number is position 20. Anyone paying at the ramp would be next in line 21, 22.... and so on.

We will continue, most likely on a permanent basis, weighing fish as you exit the water with your vessel. This causes less stress on the fish. The tournament committee and officers must be out first, no exceptions. We will announce scales open and you can retrieve your boat and pull to the scales. (We are moving away from boat numbers called to scale.)
