FAN MOTOR & BLADE CHANGE OUT

- 1. Remove plastic fan blade from fan motor shaft.
- 2. Remove the four (4) #8 Lock Nuts.
- 3. Pull motor up through the motor brackets and cut both wires as close to the motor as possible.
- 4. Strip the wire ends from the old motor and wire them together to the new motor.
- Replace the motor back on the brackets and use the same #8 Lock Nuts.
- 6. After tighten the nuts and making sure all wires are out of the way put on the new fan blade.

TO REPLACE THE BLADE ONLY FOLLOW 7-9

- 7. Position the fan blade with the metal band on the center hub facing up.
- 8. While keeping the metal band UP, align the flat side of hole with the flat side of the motor shaft and press down.
- 9. Push the fan blade onto the shaft firmly until it comes in contact with the shoulder on shaft or seats flush with the top of the shaft.
