Cypress Elementary School Remote Learning Plan 2020-2021

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, parents may choose between in person and remote learning for their children.

Students will be enrolled in Remote Learning by quarter (9 weeks). If Remote Learning is chosen, the student will remain in Remote Learning until the end of the quarter. At the end of the quarter (9 weeks) the parent will have the option for their child to remain in Remote Learning or to attend In-Person. Remote Learning will continue to be available until further guidance is issued by the Illinois State Board of Education.

Students who will be remote learning must still register with the school district, will be required to participate in 5 clock hours of instruction daily, must be in contact with their teacher daily, and will need a reliable internet connection with an available device to access and complete activities.

Remote Learning:

- Curriculum will be as demanding as in-person learning and similar in nature. Students are
 expected to be engaged daily and participate in 5 clock hours of instruction. Students who do not
 engage and who are not completing assignments will be considered truant and will be reported to
 the Regional Office of Education Truancy Officer.
- Our goal for those who are remote learning is to improve our audio and video capabilities to allow students to follow along remotely via video during daily instruction from 8am - 2pm.
- Students will be expected to video conference with their teachers regularly. Teachers will have time set aside daily between 2pm and 3pm to hold video conferences with remote learning students.
- Assignments will have due dates and must be turned in on time.
- Grades will count towards the student's GPA and Cumulative Record and will be assigned letter grades.
- Platform of delivery will be online (ex. Google Classroom, Moby Max, iReady Math, Video Instruction) From time to time, there may be paper materials that will need to be picked up at school. Materials may be picked up from the tote outside of the cafeteria door. Please avoid picking up during drop off and pick up times. (7:40am - 8:15am and 1:40 pm - 2:15pm)
- If you choose to send your child(ren) back to in person instruction after the first nine weeks, they will need to bring their school supplies with them.

Students who are remote learning will need to pick up their books on Friday, August 14th between 2:15 pm and 4pm in the cafeteria. More information regarding remote learning will be sent home at that time.
