If your child is 10 - 16 years-old, we invite them to participate!

Children 10 to 16 years-old are invited to participate in a speech perception study.

Participants should be native New Yorkers, fluent only in English, with normal speech, language & hearing, who are willing to participate in an electrophysiology study.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

During the study, your child will be seated in a quiet room with an electrode cap on their head. He/she will be asked to complete age-appropriate memory and listening tasks. His/her brain activity will be recorded. This will help us to see the differences in how the brain performs when children and teens are engaged in different types of tasks.

A speech, language and hearing screening will be conducted by a licensed and certified Speech-Language Pathologist and results will be made available to you.

The study will take place in a single session lasting 2-3 hours.
Payment for participation is \$12 per hour.
