Latvia trip

A group from our church went to Latvia, LV a small country just off of the Baltic Sea to help work on some buildings for a church camp near the village of Uzava. With a strong emphasis on completion of our work, we were able to accomplish much in a short period of time. In other words we pushed hard, painting, installing flooring and siding for the few short days we had. The camp is used in the summer for youth groups and other training classes. I understand that the whole summer is already booked up.

It was interesting to see the Christian work going on in country as we traveled across Latvia. We were able to see a church in Riga that was built in 1933. The Soviet union took over the church to use it for a theater. They removed floors and bricked up windows during their conversion to the theater that was used by the elite. After the dissolution of the Soviet Union, the property was returned to the church convention. Floors are now being replaced and classrooms rebuilt. The renovation is impressive. The church congregation of 20 people, is small and poor, so their classrooms serve a dual purpose, being rented out to raise needed income.

We shared Sunday morning church service, in a beautiful church in a small town where the gospel seems to be strong and viable. We sang worship songs that were familiar to us but with words that we didn't recognize. It was beautiful to see the small children that were there, learning and being taught the Good News of the Bible. Something to be praying about for that church, is that they were older, middle aged people and young children, but the youth were few.

I also had the opportunity to share with three people specifically on the airplane flights. A Muslim by the name of Mahamoud listened as I shared my story about Christ's love with him. Since he is allowed to read the Bible I suggested that he read the book of John. The other two, Jeremy and Mariama were reminded of the importance of getting back into regular church attendance.

Each of us have opportunities to serve the Lord each day. As you pray ask the Lord to give you opportunities that The Holy Spirit can use for eternal effect.




