



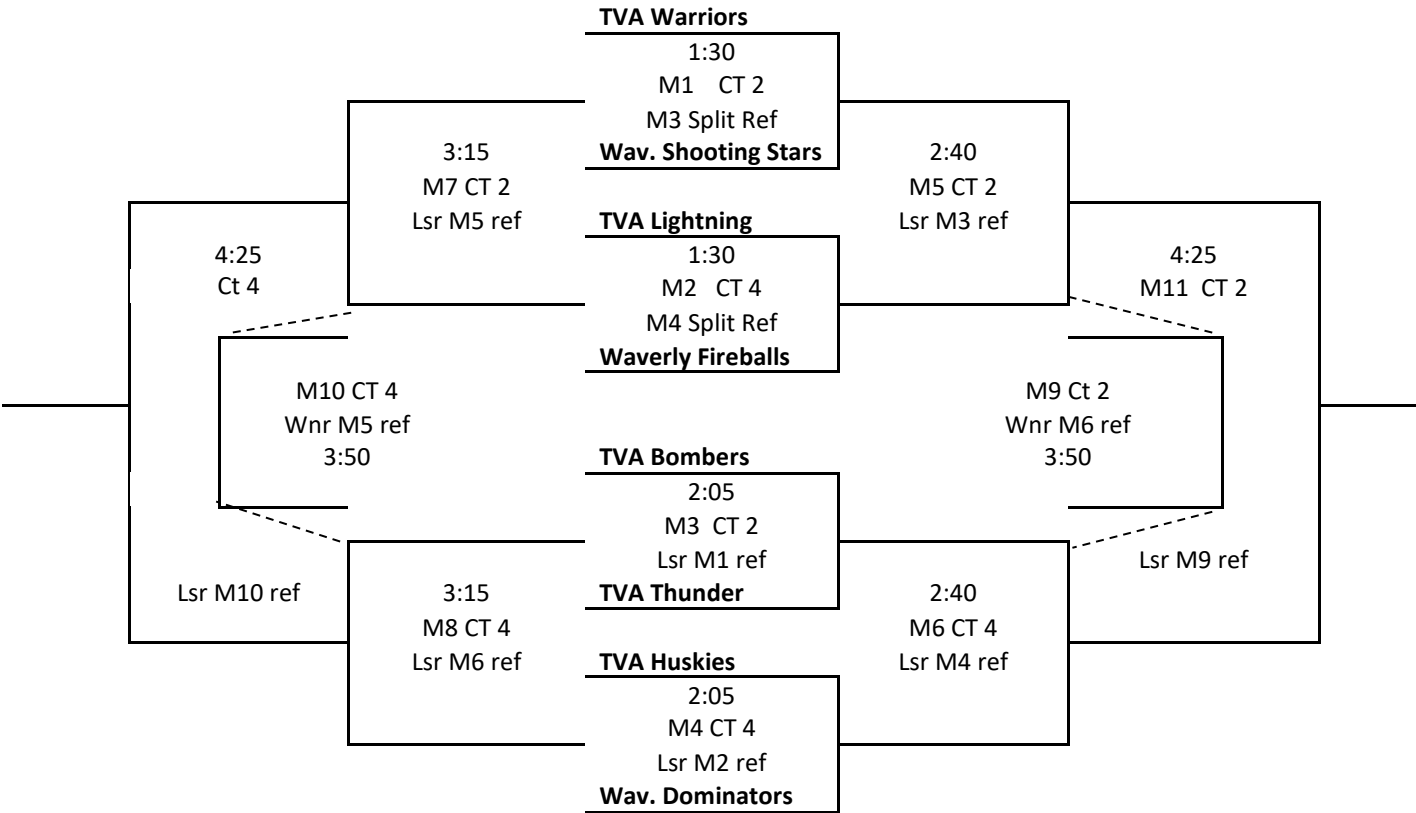

Directions to TVA

Address: **11934 Portal Road, Omaha, NE 68128**

- From Interstate I-80
- take exit 442, also referred to as the Giles/Harrison Exit (Exit for Cabela's)
- turn (south) to head toward Giles, you will pass through two lights
- turn right (south) at the 3rd light (120th & Giles intersection). Our New facility is on your left after the bridge
- turn left (east) on Portal Road.

TVA Facility Rules

1. All players when entering the facility must immediately go upstairs to the mezzanine and change into your playing gear in the "team rack area". All bags must be placed in the racks. Bags are not allowed on the playing floor or on the first level.
2. Spectators, you may bring in your own chairs, **these are ONLY ALLOWED in the mezzanine area. Absolutely no personal chairs on the main floor, not even on the cement area.**
3. We will have seating on the floor area. Please do not move the chairs to a different location.
4. Concessions will be available.
5. **You ARE ALLOWED to bring your own food into the facility.** If you wish to bring in a cooler, it may only be in the mezzanine area. No coolers allowed in the team rooms.
6. **Balls and carts are provided**, do not bring your bag or balls into the facility.
7. It would be greatly appreciated if coaches could please make sure their team cleans up their "camp" area.

TVA Tournament Rules

Warm-up:

1st matches will be a 1-3-3 warm up that will include your serving. That is 1 min both teams share the court, then 3 min for serving team, followed by 3 min for receiving team. The remaining matches will be 2-2, and these times include your team serving.

Navy Division: Matches will be two sets (games) to 25, start at 4. No third set (game). The team with the best set record will be the champion. In case of a tie, champion will be determined by 1) Head to Head results.

Orange Division: Matches will be two sets (games) to 25, start at 7, third game will be played if necessary starting at 4 points. All teams will play three matches.

Special Tournament Rules for 3-4 Grade:

Serving: Players are allowed to start serving at Cone 1 in Orange and Blue Divisions, Cone 3 in Navy Division, after scoring 3 points in a row, server must move back to next cone. Each player will get a "mulligan" serve, meaning if you miss your 1st serve of the rotation you get another serve. They will keep serving until the other team has a Sideout. This is to help facilitate more play. The 1st missed serve DOES NOT count as a point for the opponent, it is a replay. Any other missed serve does.

Three Contact Tournament:

We will award 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for the teams who have the most 3 contact points at the end of the tournament from both divisions combined. All coaches must keep track of 3 contacts on their side. Here is how you must score the 3 contacts: 1 pt = 3 contacts and not over or in the opponent's court, 2 pts = any three contacts that goes over and into your opponent's court. We want to encourage the correct style of play. Coaches must turn in their 3 contact points to the tournament table after each match.
