Dear Residents of The Greens of Elgin,

I wanted to remind you all of a couple of things since the weather is becoming more favorable.

- Window/Outside Door Treatments All window and patio/balcony door treatments are to appear white on the exterior, regardless of the interior color, type or style.
- Patio/Balcony Areas Residents whose condominiums have a patio, or a balcony are welcome to decorate the area with flowers, furniture, or decor of their choosing. However, residents are expected to clean and maintain any flowers, plants, furniture, etc. that are located on the patio or balcony, and to keep the area free from unsightly clutter. Residents on the 2nd and 3rd floor need to be respectful of those below them. Items must remain on the patio or balcony. If you are on the first floor, items cannot be placed in the grass beyond your railing.
- We have very limited parking spaces available at the property. If you are not currently driving your vehicle on a regular basis, please consider relocating your vehicle to the rear of the property. This will give other residents access to parking.
- There will be further information provided regarding the ComEd meter replacement. There will be a small window of time that the electricity will be disrupted. You will be notified when that project is going to take place.
- We conduct our Board Workshop's on Tuesdays at 10am in the Activity Room and all owners are welcome to join us.


