Scholarship Singles Tournament Rules

1. This is a *handicap* tournament. Handicap will be calculated at one hundred percent (100%) of the difference of the individual's entering average and 230.
 - Boys and Girls divisions will be recognized.
2. Those bowlers on the Prize List of the aforementioned divisions shall receive a scholarship. The monetary amount awarded in these scholarships is based on entries. Scholarship ratio will be 1 in 5 or better.
3. AVERAGES shall be based on each bowler's highest book average for the 2023-2024 bowling season; minimum of twenty-one (21) games. If no 2023-2024 average exists, use current average as of October 27, 2024 minimum of 12 games (please provide a copy of your league standing sheet as of October 27, 2024).
4. League official or bowler should check-in thirty (30) minutes prior to the commencement of the squad. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of the individual's spot in the tournament.
5. All squads shall begin at scheduled times. Late bowlers shall receive a zero (0) score for all frames missed.
6. No changes to lane assignments after they have been assigned.
7. Only tournament officials, score monitors, and tournament bowlers are permitted in the settee area.
8. Bowlers must remain in the bowler's area and be ready to take their turn.
9. Bowlers are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship. Showboating or behavior which may denigrate, distract or humiliate your fellow bowlers will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from the tournament without refund.
10. **Bowlers in direct competition MUST be dressed in accordance with the PA State Tournament dress code:**
 - All clothing must cover all undergarments and have no holes.
 - Acceptable clothing: Shirts must have sleeves.
 - Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
 - No electronic devices may be worn or operated during competition.**Penalty: First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from competition.**
11. All USBC rules will be observed.
12. Tournament results shall be posted within thirty (30) days of the conclusion of the tournament. All participating centers will be provided with a copy of the final results.
