Millie Jacoby, 94, of Unionville, passed away on Friday, January 28, 2005. She was born in Saginaw on January 19, 1911, the daughter of John and Marie Elizabeth (Fischer) Ruppal. Millie married Jacob Jacoby on May 2, 1929 in Sebewaing. Together, they had been members of the Unionville Moravian Church for many years, where she had also been a member of the Ladies Aid and taught Sunday school. She was a past president of the Unionville PTA and she and Jake were king and queen of the Unionville Centennial Celebration in 1979. Surviving, along with Jake, her loving husband of 75 years, are their children, James Jacoby and his wife, Mary Ellen, of Unionville, Betty Brinkman and her husband, Robert, of Caro, and Bonnie Brinkman and her husband, Jack, of Cass City; 10 grandchildren; 26 great-grandchildren; and seven great-great-grandchildren. Also surviving are a brother, Harold Ruppal and his wife, Norma, of Akron; a sister, Clare Halabis, of Caro; and a sister-in-law, Genevieve Ruppal, of Akron.
