Library Update

I hope everyone is enjoying this spring season! And I hope we will have several more weeks of spring temperatures before summertime temperatures take over.

Teresa Burns, Program Coordinator, has been very busy planning our **Summer Reading Program** Program along with Elizabeth Roller, Services Librarian. Library Assistant T'Kayah Mitchell, has taken the lead on getting the library decorated and included all our talented and artistic staff for this job for this year's program. Our summer reading theme is Oceans of Possibilities. This program will run for six weeks, starting June 6. Each week will have a different theme and different activities to learn about oceans, ocean animals, pollution and our impact on the oceans, and recycling. We will learn about ocean myths and mysteries, the seven seas and the countries and cultures near each ocean, and oceans start up river. We will even have a shark week and a pirate week.

Each week will also have a special program such as **Bob Tarter's Animalogy** program, **Mr. Bond and the Science Guys, Barry Mitchell's Deep Sea Circus, TWRA and the creek walk**, and a virtual program with the **Tennessee Aquarium**. We are also partnering with **UT Southern** for an adult **Marine Biology** program. There will be something for all ages during the six weeks of summer reading. At the end, we will have a big summer reading party for all who participate with prizes, games, fun and food. So make sure you get yourself, your kids and grandkids signed up for a great summer reading with Oceans of Possibilities! And read all summer long!

Oceans of Possibilities Crafting Evening - If you have a desire to do some crafting in the near future, you are in luck! We are hosting an adult crafting evening on May 16th from 5:30-7:00. We will be making ocean themed crafts that will help decorate the library for summer reading. We will provide all the supplies and you can take home your creations at the end of summer reading. Join us for a fun evening of crafting.

The **SunDrop Fest** is happening on Saturday, June 11. The library along with Pulaski Electric will have the kid's corner (activities for kids) along Second Street between Pulaski Electric and Giles County Public Library. Bring your kids for a fun filled afternoon and evening and enjoy all the activities, music, and good food that the SunDrop Fest has to offer.

Lemonade Day is happening in our communities on May 20. Lemonade

Day is a **free**, fun, experiential learning program that teaches youth how to start, own and operate their own business — a lemonade stand. All third graders in the county will have gone through this learning program at school. So if you see a lemonade stand or several lemonade stands while you are out and about on Friday, May 20, please stop and help these awesome third graders with their businesses.

Crypto Currency — Are you curious about all you see and hear about crypto currency? Do you want to know what it is? Do you want to know how it works? We are working to have a speaker here for a program on this topic soon. Stay tuned for the date and time.

Don't forget that all of our library patrons now have access to the **Consumer Reports Database**. All you need is your library card number to log in and get product information, reviews and news on everything that Consumer Reports has to offer. Come in and get a free library card if you don't already have one to access the Consumer Reports database to do your research on anything before you actually buy a product.

Summer brings lots of water activities such as boating. If you need a boating license, you can take the boating test at the library. We also have the study books for the boating test.

The library has so many great resources. We hope you will take advantage of all the free resources and information that the library has to offer. We also have the best search engines. They are called librarians!
