New Business:

- Participation of all members in 2022 was reviewed. The club rule of minimum 6 rounds played per year with exemptions for sponsors and medical reasons was enforced. Members who failed to meet this criteria were placed at the bottom of the membership list below new applicants. As a result, 5 members were removed from the current membership list for the 2023 season.
- Membership dues for 2023
 - Moved by Bob Kobzey to raise membership dues from \$150.00 to \$195.00 2nd T Spring Jr
 - Discussion: our prices and costs are continuing to rise and we need extra revenue to help offset this and provide a good format for our membership. Motion carried
- Milestone shirts
 - Milestone arm tags will be added to existing Club shirts rather than as a special order to help maintain costs. A few members have stated that they did not receive their 10 Year Member Milestone shirts. This is being investigated.
- Future Club Championship Formats
 - Many members would rather play the Championship from the White tees rather than the Blues (as done in regular tournaments). Also, discussion was made to change the structure to have 2 Tiers rather than the 3 that are currently being used.
