

TOWN OF CLOVERDALE
ORDINANCE # 1998-10

AN ORDINANCE TO DEFINE ON-STREET PARKING

WHEREAS, the Town of Cloverdale has determined that the elimination or adjustment of a portion of on-street parking spaces on Market Street is in the best interest of public health and safety;

WHEREAS, on-street parking on the South side of Market Street beginning at the Southwest corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending fifty-five feet (55) from the corner West on the South side of Market Street interferes with the safe passage of fire protection vehicles;

WHEREAS, angled parking on the North side of Market Street beginning at the Northwest corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending seventy-five feet (75) from the corner East on the North side of Market Street interferes with the safe passage of traffic;

WHEREAS, angled parking on the North side of Market Street beginning at the Northeast corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending fifty-five feet (55) from the corner East on the North side of Market Street interferes with the safe passage of traffic;

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale as follows:

No parking shall be allowed on the South side of Market Street beginning at the Southwest corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending fifty-five feet (55) from the corner West on the South side of Market Street;

Only parallel parking is allowed on the North side of Market Street beginning at the Northwest corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending seventy-five feet (75) from the corner West on the North side of Market Street; and

No parking shall be allowed on the North side of Market Street beginning at the Northeast corner of Market Street and US 231 and ending fifty-five (55) from the corner East on the North side of Market Street.

This Ordinance shall have full force and effect upon passage of the Cloverdale Town Board. Violation of this ordinance will follow the fines set forth in Ordinance No. 1986-6.
