

Raymond E. Guza Born: January 31, 1918 Died: March 18, 2015



Raymond E. Guza, 97, of Port Austin, passed away peacefully on March 18, 2015 at Huron Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe.

Raymond was born on January 31, 1918 to the late John P. and Emma (Kappler) Guza in Ubly, Michigan.
