LITTLE HERSHEY PHONE CONFERENCE, JAN 4th

We had a phone conference call Monday evening to discuss the results of the conversation with the Farm Girl Main Street Market folks concerning their willingness to meet our requests and to confirm our understanding of the terms of relocating our Car Show/Parts Meet to the other side of the Boone County Fairgrounds.

Dave Lantz, our Little Hershey Chairman/Point Man, informed us that the Farm Girl folks agree (that for as long as they stay in our old fair ground location) that they will pay rent for our spaces. This includes:

- the use of two buildings (referred to as the Poultry Building and Goat Building)
- 6 port a potties
- 2 ticket booths
- 6 or more handicap parking spaces
- +- 60 indoor vendor spaces
- +/- 240 outdoor vendor spaces
- the ability to paint/spray/identify vendor spaces
- Use of Gate #3 as our primary access/egress

We will also have access to power and water and a specified indoor space for our club tables/space.

We also briefly discussed and confirmed that our admission fee will \$7.00 and that our Car Show will actually be like our last one - a Cruise In and we will charge passengers \$5.00.

We also briefly acknowledged that we will need new signage.

Little Hershey: Dave Lantz said the club will be moving the Little Hershey location at the Boone County Fairgrounds to the southeast corner of the fairground, to Gates 3 and 4. Dave said the club will get use of the poultry and goat buildings and shelter and rental fees will be paid by Urban Farmgirl, along with 6 port - o - potties, a ticket booth and six handicap parking spaces. the entrance fee will be \$7.00 general admission, \$5.00 per car for cruise - in (fee includes driver and one passenger, additional passengers \$5.00 each). Duane Bunton said he is volunteering to sell the club's storage items and club members' swap meet items a vendor space. Mention was made that a portable wash station was needed for the event and Dave said he would look into renting a wash station. Discussion took place stating event signs are needing to say that Little Hershey was moved to a new location. Dave said he will be needing help with advertising the event; states the ads will need to be placed around April. Dave was thanked by club members for his hard work for the Little Hershey event for the past few years.

Past Club Events: Wayne Henson said the New Years Day tour was cancelled.

Future Club Events: Wayne Henson said once the weather is better towards Spring, a date needs to be set to clean out the club's items currently being stored in a shed at Craig's house. Craig said it's OK to continue storing items until a time when the weather is better for clean out.
