All applications must adhere to the following guidelines and criteria unless otherwise stated:

- Completed application -typed
- Typed 500 -word essay
- Official transcript (can be emailed)
- Evidence of community service
- Evidence of extracurricular activities
- Two Letters of Recommendation
  - o one from a guidance counselor or teacher
  - o one from a non-related adult that has known you more than 3 years
- Optional, additional information could include an outstanding academic accomplishment, a family financial crisis, an outstanding accomplishment other than academics.
- Copy of college or university letter of acceptance stating you have met all requirements.

Remember to apply for ALL scholarships that you meet requirements for.

- All packets are due to Nursing CAP April 21, 2023
- Incomplete packets will not be accepted.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the End-of-Year Ceremony in June . Recipients are expected to attend.

Please be sure your completed application includes all required information. Partial applications and supportive materials will not be accepted. All information and required documents should be included in the application email. Multiple emails will not be accepted.

# NURSING CAP, INCORPORATED SCHOLARSHIPS 2023

Nursing CAP, Incorporated will award eleven (11) scholarships to <u>participants/past-participants of the Nursing CAP Program</u>. Below are the monetary amounts and a brief description of the scholarships as well as the essay topics and writing points that should be covered in the essay(s) that will accompany the application.

- \$1000.00 ~ Dr. Connie M. Webster Scholarship High School Graduate (1 Awarded). This scholarship is given to honor the brave Nursing Heroes in the profession, and students seeking to become nurses. The ideal high school graduate candidate(s) will have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and will have demonstrated a high interest in community, civic, and/or volunteer service, along with demonstrated academic gains, leadership skills, and a need for financial assistance. The student must matriculate at an accredited institution of higher learning and plan to major in nursing. The essay topic: "Why I want to become a nurse."
- Specific Writing points:
  - What inspires you to become a nurse?
  - What issues occurring today indicate that nurses are important and needed?
  - What specific areas of healthcare would you like to make an impact?
  - How has Nursing CAP, Inc. impacted your decision?
  - Discuss the importance of ethics and integrity as a student.
- ❖ \$1000.00 ~ Dr. Connie M. Webster Scholarship Continuing Student
  The ideal continuing student must be enrolled and passing nursing courses. In
  addition,he/she must belong to a student nursing organization or have shown leadership
  in organizing or participating in a health-related community activity. The scholarship will
  be awarded to applicants determined to be best qualified under the terms and conditions
  of eligibility. The essay topic: "Current ethical issues in nursing"

  - How would you define an ethical nursing practice?
  - As a nurse of color, what would you like to accomplish?
  - Why do you think nurses are leaving the profession and what can be done to change it?
