
The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary



The Odgen Valley Land Trust and Summit Land Conservancy are working with willing landowners to protect an iconic 1,084-acre property that was once home to the Abbey of Our Lady of the Holy Trinity, a Trappist Cistercian monastery established in 1947 in Huntsville, Utah.

We are reaching out to the community to ask for financial help to partially compensate the owners of the monastery property for the value of the conservation easement they are creating. We need to raise the final \$300,000 for this project. We welcome anyone who will join us in saving this legacy for future generations by protecting valuable open space from development; preserving an iconic, historical, spiritual landmark; and ensuring the survival of critical habitat for the Valley's amazing wildlife. Tax deductible donations will ensure that the monk' memory and this beautiful crown jewel in Ogden Valley will be protected forever.
