Spirit, Soul and Body By Wade Anderson

Somewhere in August or September of 2016 the Holy Spirit began stirring inside of me, through the Scriptures I was directed to, the numerous books I was reading, teaching CD's I was listening too and the sermon teachings I was sitting under that I was to bring a deeper revelation, through the Word of God, concerning Grace. It is time to rightly divide God's Grace from the legalistic and religious teachings that so many of us have been held in bondage to for so long. Although the October 2016, Grace Through Faith, message was not titled as Part1 it was the first area we established that was to help us break free from those chains that USED to hold us captive.

Let's pray: "Heavenly Father, we are so grateful for Your Word because we know that it is the truth. We know that it has NEVER been Your purpose/plan for us to be captives to ANYTHING. We know this because You GAVE Your One and only Son to break us free from the bondages of Pharisees of false teachings. You gave us Your Word, Your Son Jesus, AND then deposited Your Holy Spirit inside each of us to counsel us and guide us in this New and much better covenant, that has been (past tense) made available through Christ. So, right now, I invite Your Holy Spirit to be the teacher in all that is written on these pages. I pray that if there is ANYTHING here that is NOT of You that it be washed away in the Blood of Jesus and only truth be revealed. I ask You these things in complete confidence that You DO hear and answer our prayers. In Jesus name, AMEN, AMEN, and AMEN!"

In that October 2016 issue of the newsletter, I shared many different Scriptures and today I'm going to share some of them again. These are only a few of the many foundational Scriptures that we have to build our new Christian lives upon. These truths are ever important to plant and cultivate in our hearts in order to move forward in our adventurous journey with Jesus. It is also important because someone may not have gotten the October 2016 issue. I believe it's even more important to give the whole Scripture and not just give the address. In other words, repetition builds familiarity. From this end I have access to many, many translations to where some of you may not even have Bibles. In that case what good would the address (example *Mark 11:22*) do you if you didn't know what was at that address? "*Hare fills in @@@."* (*Mark 11:22*) Now you know what lives at that address.

"For it is BY GRACE that you have been saved, THROUGH FAITH - and this is NOT from yourselves, it is THE GIFT of God - not by works, so that no man can boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

"For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to ALL men." (Titus 2:11)

"Having been born again, NOT of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the Word of God (Jesus) which lives and abides forever ..." (1 Peter 1:23)

Before we move on, I want to encourage everyone once again ... as you read through Paul's letter's underline every place you come across a phrase like, *in Him, in Whom, in Christ, with Him, through Christ, through Him,* etc. After you do that stop and take a few minutes to digest the promises you have IN Christ given in that area. Then begin to confess these things over your lives. Here is a couple examples. "God made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that IN HIM we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Corinthians 5:21) "I can do ALL things through Christ who strengthens me." (Philippians 4:13) Instead of kicking, cry babying and begging God to do something that He has already done for us, we have got to load our hearts with the ammunition, His Word, that we've already been given in order to stand firm whenever opposition comes our way.

In Ephesians 4:22-25, listen as Paul compels us to put on the new man, "You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put OFF your old man, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; and to PUT ON the New Man, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." In Romans 13:14 we see, "... CLOTH yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the desires of the flesh."

Now don't start throwing things at me but I find these Scriptures interesting, very insightful and painting a pretty clear picture of IN Christ being revealed to us as similar to a garment. Isn't that what Paul just said? *Cloth yourselves ... Put On the New man.* Don't get all religious on me. I'm just quoting what Paul wrote. But, instead look at what Paul is saying like this. I know from time to time many of you 'get' to wear those big orange jump suits for your general dress attire so you can relate to this illustration. (sick humor I know) Now, grab hold of that 'Jesus' jump suit and imagine that it is form fitting and goes completely over your head. Next, step IN TO it one leg at a time. Then place each arm IN TO the sleeves and pull "Him" up over your shoulders. Now, reach down towards the bottom of the 'Suit', in the front, and grab hold of the zipper. Pull the zipper all the way up and over the top of your head. At that point there is NOTHING left of the 'old man' that is visible. To me, this is the picture I see Paul painting when he says to, "*Cloth yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, Put On the New Man.*" Now I know we don't literally have to do this because we are already IN Him and He is IN us but, do you see the picture? "*I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ now lives in me.*"

The life I live in the body, I live BY FAITH in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me." (Galatians 2:20)

Believe me it's totally to our advantage to understand that this is the way the enemy sees us when we are clothed IN CHRIST! I can also tell you that walking by faith means we have to zip it all the way over our head. Leaving the zipper down far enough to see out in front of us is NOT total faith in God and the enemy knows it. Second Corinthians 5:7 says, "For we walk by faith, NOT by sight." I can tell you that as I began to picture myself clothed IN the New Man, 'Jesus suit', I too began to view the obstacles that lay in front of me in wait much differently. I know that we will travel here again at a later date so for now, we'll move on.

Let's turn over to 2 Corinthians 5:14-15 (NIV) and read, "For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that One died for all, and therefore all died. And He died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for Him who died for them and was raised again." Now, 2 Corinthians 5:17 tells us, "Therefore, if ANYONE is IN CHRIST, he is a NEW creation; the old has gone, the NEW has come." Notice it doesn't say, rich people, poor people, well educated people, those in prison or out of prison, or those with little or no education. It says ANYONE! Anyone, "... that if you will confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord, and BELIEVE IN YOUR HEART that God raised Him from the dead, YOU WILL be saved." (Romans 10:9-10) If you have done this then you're a qualifier as an ANYONE. Everyone who has already done this should be praising Jesus for the access to the throne room of God! And to all of you who have already asked Jesus to be the Lord of your lives then that right there should excite you enough to share this same invitation with others wherever you are. Let me just say this. Now that you ARE saved it doesn't please the devil. BUT here's the great thing about that, there is absolutely nothing he can do about it! Listen as Jesus gave us this promise in John 10:28-29. "I give them elarnel lifts, and they shall never periods, no ene will smatch them out of Kiy hand. Ky Pather, who has given them to Kie, is greater then all; no one can smatch them out of My Father's hand."

I'm just going to step out here and say, we just seen that there is absolutely nothing the enemy can do about your salvation because it is 'sealed'. But, the reason he throws so much opposition at us once we are saved is because he wants to discourage us in our own walks so that we might be distracted from sharing Jesus and taking someone else along with us. This is the way that I personally approach that situation each morning whether I'm going in to the jails or simply moving through my day. "This is the day that the Lord has made, I will rejoice and be glad in it! Lord use me today to be a blessing to someone somewhere, that Your will for my life here and NOW is being fulfilled ... devil, you have absolutely NO power over me because I am the righteousness of God, IN Christ Jesus. I take my authority and I exercise it today AND every day! I'm telling everyone that will listen that you are a liar NOT a lion! My desire is to continue with what the Lord's plan and purpose is for my life! I'm Not going to heaven by myself! AND I'm taking bus loads of others with me that will listen and respond to Jesus' voice! So beat it!!"

Let's go back and take a look at what the Bible says about being 'sealed'. In Ephesians 1:13-14, (NKJV), we find, "IN Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; IN Whom also, having believed, you were (past tense, already) sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, Who IS the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession (us), to the praise of His glory." Now let's go find the definition of 'trusted'. First thing we want to notice is that 'trusted' is the past tense of trust, meaning we've already did/already given our trust. When we look in the New Lexicon Webster Dictionary we find the definition of trust to be; confidence in a person or a thing because of the qualities we perceive in him or it, acceptance of something as true and reliable without at first being able to verify it, to have faith in, to rely on and trust in God. What I would draw from this definition is, when we first believed we 'should have' placed our complete confidence and acceptance in the qualities and reliability, by faith, in what God has already completed for us. When we fully trust in God it takes all of the 'I have to do's or our works' out of the equation. WHEN we rely on His finished work, NOT OURS, THEN we can rest in His promises. I can hear some of you saying, "What about James 2:17 where it tells us, 'Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being alone ?" Okay, the difference in what I just said and what this Scripture in James is saying is; It is NOT our works that draws God close to us or that God has a check list for us to meet in order for us to get our prayers answered or receive our healing. By faith we believed therefore we are qualifiers to receive. What James is saying, in context, is (my paraphrase) ... we say we have faith in God but when we see another person in need of something that we ourselves can provide for them why do we turn our head the other way?? God has provided all of our needs by His riches in glory through Christ Jesus. We ARE His hands, feet, and mouth piece here on earth! The works that James is speaking about here is that WE DO something with that faith and help provide for that other person in need. Believe me, God gives us EVERYTHING we need and if we give it away He will ALWAYS give it back to us! It says so right here in Luke 6:38. "@htm. and it WILL bo alwan to your. A good measure, pressed down, sheken together and running over, WILL BE poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." Folks those are red lettered words, a promise from the very lips of Jesus! In Philippians 4:19 Paul assures us, "And my God will meet ALL your needs according to the riches of His glory IN Christ Jesus."

Thank you all for welcoming me in to your family at the Orcconcers for Stirist. That's a BIG blessing. Thank you for the nice cards and the newsletters that you send. I am so blessed to have you all in my life. I always think about you all there at the OC+C and want you to know you are in my prayers. I love to read the stories from others around the country along with the Scriptures and the messages. Thank you all for your hard work and time. What you all do helps those of us that are locked up to get into God's Word and learn to praise Him.

I thank God that He gave me the strength to reach out to this ministry. Let me tell you a little bit about why. I was born and raised as a Catholic and I always went to Catholic services. It was confusing to me because all that they did was recite the rosary. The reason that I kept going for so long was that I was seeking and hoping that one day they would talk about God. I really wanted to know about God ... I wanted a relationship with Him. That never did happen for me there so I stopped going to services.

Then one day I seen all these women sitting and reading at a table here on the yard. I seen that they all had their own Bibles so I asked them if I could join them and they said yes. I truly believe that God showed me the way to these ladies. They asked me if I went to any services on the yard and I told them that I used to go to the Catholic ones but I stopped because they never talked about God. Then one of the ladies asked me if I would like to come to one of the Christian services to see if I would like it there. LET ME TELL YOU ... I loved it and not only that, I got touched by the Holy Spirit! I couldn't stop crying. It seemed like everything the pastor was saying had to do with me. I LOVED IT! Everything the pastor was talking about was what I had been yearning for. These services were talking about God and telling me how I too could have a relationship with Him.

The very next day I put in a request to change from the Catholic services to the Christian services. I gave my life over to Christ on March 13, 2013 and that has been the best thing that I have ever done in my life! I'm still taking baby steps but one day I can see myself in the same shoes as all of you. Thanks to the grace of God He gives me the strength to keep going forward. If I didn't have Him I don't know how I would carry on with my life.

That keeps me positive and I put my trust and faith fully into God and I know He will make a way, He always does. All the trials and suffering I've been through growing up in CPS; being a single mom, drug addict, alcoholic and now my crime and all this time I have seen it as a true blessing. Yes, it may sound crazy but I believe God is doing His purpose in my life, here on earth, to prepare me for eternity in heaven.

I may stumble but I get myself right back on up and move forward. Satan can never win this battle, because I'm equipped with the full Armor of God. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift! (*2 Corinthians 9:15*) May God bless each and every one of you. May God bless you abundantly and that you all prosper. Thank you so much for all that you do!!! You're the best.

Thank you so very much for the card, it brought tears of joy to me, just knowing that someone cares. I am not going to be transferred this year and I am always fearful when I go to a new prison. Because of my crime I never know what to expect. I know that feeling fear is part of life, I just have to learn to deal with it because it will never completely go away. I usually just do what I believe I am supposed to do, even if I have to do it afraid. I've watched people put a name on how they hate me, because I am a sex offender. They even put a label on me. I lost my identity and my integrity and nobody hates me more than me for what I have done. A name is a lot to lose. When you don't have a good name, doors will close on you when they haven't even met you yet.

By the grace of God, I haven't lost my faith. Some people put faith in themselves, some in other people and some in things. But I put my faith in God. I am so very sorry for my sinful actions and it grieves me every day that I disappointed God, my family and my children. You know this month is Father's Day. Do you know how much it hurts me when my children won't even send me a Father's Day card because they no longer want nothing to do with me? I have to keep believing that I can handle whatever life hands me, and do whatever I need to do through Christ. I found that my attitude towards unpleasant things is an important part of going through them successfully. But it's hard to do when it comes to the ones you love. I do believe God gives us the strength to bear up under our challenge, and to go through it with a good attitude. Do you think that your attitude is actually more important than your challenges?

Since I've been in prison I have been maturing in the Word and when I'm thinking positive thoughts the devil attacks my thoughts and my mind-set gets all messed up. I feel like the devil wants me to become self-focused by making me try to figure out what's wrong with my thinking. How could I have done such a shameful thing? I have been tormented by questions such as these, and the feelings that accompany them. I am trying real hard to develop a positive mind-set so that my life could be more pleasant. People are everywhere and you never know what they might say or do. Why should I give control of my day to other people? Being hurt and offended does not change the people, it only changes you. I have been through some of the consequences of offense, such as insults, hatred and attacks. And when this happens to me, I pray for the Lord to work through me to not allow these negative and poisonous emotions to rule my life. Love bears up under anything, and everything that comes, is ready to believe the best of every person, it's hopes are fadeless under all circumstances and it endures everything without weakening. I was blessed to find your publication with your address, so I took it as a sign from the Lord to write. So here I am. What I am hoping for is some correspondence with someone, anyone at the church. I'm not sure if you have that type of program, but I'm just putting it out there. Thank you very much.

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

2 Chronicles 1:1 - 6:11

Solomon could have had anything, but he asked for wisdom to rule the nation. Because God approved of the ways Solomon ordered his priorities, He gave Solomon wealth, riches and honor as well. Jesus also spoke about priorities. He said that when we put God first, everything we really need will be given to us as well. (Matthew 6:33) This does not guarantee that we will be wealthy and famous like Solomon, but it means that when we put God first, the wisdom He gives will enable us to have richly rewarding lives. When we have a purpose for living and learn to be content with what we have, we have greater wealth than we could ever imagine. (1:11-12)

God's work can be moved forward when the older generation paves the way for the younger. (2:1)

The craftsmen followed God's specifications carefully with spectacular results. When God gives specific instructions, they must be followed to the letter. There is a time to be creative and to put forth our own ideas, but not when the ideas add to, alter, or contradict any specific directions God has already given to us in the Bible. For best results in your spiritual life, carefully seek and follow God's instructions. (4:7)

The first service at the temple began with honoring God and acknowledging His presence and goodness. In the same way, our worship should begin by acknowledging God's love. Praise God first, then you will be prepared to present your needs to Him. Recalling God's love and mercy will inspire you to worship Him daily. *Psalm 107* is an example of how David recalled God's enduring love. (5:13)

Romans 6:1-7:13

If God loves to forgive, why not give Him more to forgive? If forgiveness is guaranteed, do we have freedom to sin as much as we want to? Paul's forceful answer is, "Of course not!" Such an attitude, deciding ahead of time to take advantage of God shows that a person does not understand the seriousness of sin. Jesus paid with His life so we could be forgiven. The availability of God's mercy must not become an excuse for careless living and moral laxness. (6:1-2)

When a person dies to the old life and accepts Christ as their Savior, a new life begins. An unbeliever's life is centered on his or her personal gratification. Those who don't follow Christ have only their own self-determination as their source of power. By contrast, God is at the center of a Christian's life. God supplies the power for a Christian's daily living. Believers find that their whole way of looking at the world changes when they come to Christ. (7:4)

Psalm 16:1-17:15

David's heart was glad, he had found the secret to joy. True joy is far deeper than happiness. We can feel joy in spite of our deepest troubles. Happiness is temporary because it is based on external circumstances. But joy is lasting because it is based on God's presence within us. As we contemplate his daily presence, we will find contentment. As we understand the future, He has for us, we will experience joy. Don't base your life on circumstances, but on God. (16:9)

Just as we protect the pupils (apples) of our eyes, so God will protect us. We must not conclude, however, that we have somehow missed God's protection if we experience trouble. God's protection has far greater purposes than helping us avoid pain. It is to make us better servants for Him. God also protects us by guiding us through painful circumstances, not only by helping us escape them. (17:8)

Proverbs 19:20-21

A wise person commits his or her plans to the Lord. (See 16:3) A person whose plans oppose the Lord (as in Psalm 2:1-3) may actually become God's enemy. But the person whose ways are from God will certainly succeed. (See 16:1-9) (19:21)

"Foot" Notes

Brothers and sisters, don't ever think that God does not have you in mind. No matter where you are, pay attention and you will see opportunity open up before your very eyes. God WILL move in your life so just stick with your faith in Him and things will always happen for you.

Love to you all short and tall. Don't ride faster than you angels can fly.

Spirit, Soul and Body

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Most of us, through lack of knowledge and understanding, believe that we are made up only of body and soul. Most of us believe that our spirit and our soul are one in the same. That's not correct. Listen here to what it tells us in **1** Thessalonians 5:23, (NIV), "May God Himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." This Scripture clearly defines that we are a three part being. When we look in the mirror it's pretty obvious that the 'reflection' we see is our physical body. In other words if you were fat, ugly or bald when you got saved and went directly and looked in the mirror you may be discouraged because we were still fat, ugly and bald. You may say, 'I thought the Bible just said that I was brand new?' It did. But that's not the part of you that's brand new or born again. It was our spirit that was made NEW! (I'll come back to some of that mirror stuff in a bit.) In Genesis 1:26, "God said, let US make man in OUR image, after OUR likeness:" When God said this He wasn't talking about our physical bodies. What God placed in each of us was a soul AND a spirit. Genesis 2:7 tells us that, "And the LORD formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." I'm not sure if you, right now, will find this encouraging but I do! Listen to what Solomon tells us happens with this earthly tent we are living in when we die. "Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it." (Ecclesiastes 12:7) And God made a way for that to happen ... through the life, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ!! Praise Jesus!

We can feel both our body and our soul. For instance, if someone comes up to you and places their hand on your shoulder you feel it without seeing them. Likewise, without even touching you someone can speak to our soul and in doing so make us sad, happy or mad. We all have felt the cuts inside of us when someone has said something that hurt us deeply. So obviously that old saying we were taught as kids, 'Sticks and stones can break our bones but names and accusations don't hurt you!' is NOT the whole truth.

How many of us have gotten up in the morning and almost instantly our body begins to give us a **mental** inventory of how 'it' feels? It could be telling us 'you're tired, lonely, fighting a cold or healthy.' Perhaps we step into the shower and our body says, 'This hot water sure feels good on these sore muscles today.' We step out of the shower and the body instantly sends new information, 'It's cold out here! I need to turn the heat up.' Our bodies are constantly feeding us new information. But it's not always the whole truth. Our bodies are followers. Can you see how our bodies go right along with whatever our minds, wills and emotions tells it?

We can check in with our souls and it will tell us whether we're angry, joyful, mentally worn out or ready to take on the day. Sometimes it's crazy how we can wake up from what was a great night of sleep and for some reason or another we almost instantly become aware of some sort of sadness or depression inside of us. Why? Because we are in touch with our souls. According to **Genesis 1:26** we have been made (paste tense, even before we were saved) a spirit being. Again, in **2 Corinthians 5:17** Paul says that ANYONE that steps in to that 'Jesus suit' is IN CHRIST and INSTANTLY a NEW creation, the old has gone and the NEW has come!

Through our bodies we cannot access our spirit. Since we are new creations look what John 3:6 (NKJ) tells us, "That which is born of flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit." Our soul encompasses our spirit and then our body is the outer layer of us that we can visibly see. The only way we can get what's in our New spirit to manifest fruit on the outside is to renew our minds with the Word of God. This is why Romans 12:2 (KJV), tells us, "And be not conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God." Once we are born again, what has instantly been placed in of our New spirit, in fullness, is found in Galatians 5:22-23, "But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, He will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Here there is no conflict with the law." I know many of you are asking yourself right now, 'I've asked Jesus to be the Lord of my life, why is it that I don't see much of this fruit in my life?' The answer to that, once again, is found in Romans 12:2. We find that the Apostle Paul struggled with the very same situations we do, in Romans 7:15-20, "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is the sin living in me. For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil that I do not want to do - this I keep on doing. NOW if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it." Paul sounds pretty perplexed here doesn't he? In fact the first few times I read this early on in my walk it sounded to me like he wasn't taking responsibility for his own actions. Thanks to Holy Spirit bringing a greater understanding, today I see that Paul had a true revelation of the war that goes on inside of us once we've given our lives to Jesus. It's important to understand that when Paul said, in my sinful nature he was talking about his soul NOT his born again spirit. Remember, our New spirit is born of incorruptible seed and vacuum pack sealed with the Holy Spirit. Paul even gave us the answer to what we ourselves fight with, and that is ... the struggle between our flesh and our Spirit.

Brothers and sisters, I don't know about all of you but for me, I am immensely grateful that the Holy Spirit gave such great revelation to the Apostle Paul and that he in turn wrote it down to help us find our way! AMEN?! Paul has definitely become one of my greatest Biblical/spiritual mentors! Listen here to the great spiritual advice he gives us in, *Galatians 16-18*, "So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will NOT gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. BUT if you are led by the Spirit, you are NOT under the law." And again, in Romans 7:5-6, "For when we were in the realm of the flesh, the sinful passions aroused by the law were at work in us, so that we bore fruit for death. But NOW, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and NOT in the old way of the written code (Law)." And this my friends is the goal for walking in the Spirit, Romans 7:4, "So, my brothers and sisters, you also died to the law THROUGH the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to Him who was raised from the dead (Jesus), (Why?) IN ORDER THAT WE MIGHT BEAR FRUIT FOR GOD."

Remember, it's only our spirit that has been made brand new. We still have the same soul and we still live in the same body. Our soul is made up of the mind, will, and emotions that we have always had. We also have five natural senses and our conscience to deal with. God gave us these natural senses (hearing, feeling, seeing, tasting and smelling) to help us maneuver through life easier. They are good things that we have used for sometimes the wrong reasons. So we will continue to use these five senses but NOT allow them to dictate why we do or do not do things from now on. You know what I'm saying. Just because something might taste good doesn't necessarily mean it's good for us. Just because something might feel good doesn't mean it's the right thing for us to engage in. For way too long we've been tricked and allowed our minds, wills and emotions to guide and even dictate our route through life! Now, in order to change what is in our souls we have to renew these areas with what the written Word of God says.

I'm going to stop right there for now but next month we'll pick up right here and continue on. My hope is that you all take what is written here, pray over it and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal only truth to you in your own private time with Him.
