SUBJECT: D50 & D25

ACTION:

Rapid elevation of blood glucose level.

INDICATIONS:

Hypoglycemia or Coma of unknown etiology.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

None in the emergency setting.

PRECAUTIONS:

Draw blood, determine blood glucose level. Do not allow vein extravasation. Thiamine should Be administered if there is suspicion of chronic alcohol use.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Local venous irritation.

DOSAGE:

25 grams (50 mL)

ROUTE:

IV

PEDIATRIC DOSE:

0.5 gm/kg as D25 solution slow IV
