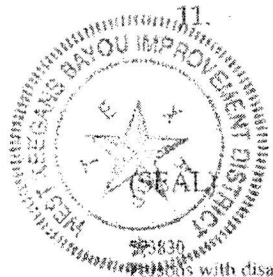

 - f. other engineering matters.
9. Landscape architect's report, including:
 - a. design of District facilities, approval of plans and specifications, authorization to advertise for bids and award of construction contracts;
 - b. construction of District facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate;
 - c. recreational facilities and amenities;
 - d. property acquisition; and
 - e. planning and design for Phase 4 of trail.
10. Update on District website and authorize appropriate action.
11. Discuss meeting schedule.
