After the "first bite" of the season, deploy Spartan Mosquito

Eradicators at approximately six feet off the ground, within 180 feet of each other, along your property line. Be sure to place them away from where people gather since mosquitoes will gather near the Eradicators. Once Spartan Mosquito Eradicators are deployed, they create a barrier, giving the mosquitoes a target that has the same attractant triggers as people and animals. Once mosquitoes feed on the water solution, they perish before they can breed again. The mosquito population in the area will then decrease in 15 days or less and up to 95% of your mosquito population will cease to exist for up to 90 days after installation.

The Spartan Mosquito Eradicator takes 10 minutes to set up and it lasts up to 90 days. Its simplicity makes it perfect for residential, governmental, and commercial use.

July in your Food Plot

Food Plot 101: There are a few seeds that are best to plant in July; Buckwheat, Sorghum and Sorghum Sudan Grass amongst a few others, but besides those, spring food plot planting, should be done by July. That doesn't mean that your work is done. For those of you who are planning to put in a fall food plot, now is the time to start planning.

- 1. Spray to get rid of the weeds
- 2. Figure out what you want to plant. What was in that plot last year? Be careful, rotation is needed.
 - a. Do you want an Annual or Perennial?
- 3. Get a soil test done, so you know what your nutrient needs are and how much fertilizer you will need. Don't forget the Lime! pH levels are critical in maintaining proper soil nutrients. For the food plot to reach its full nutritional potential, the soil's pH range should be between 6.0 to 7.0.
- 4. Decide when you want to plant your Fall Food Plot, which can be done between August and October, depending on what you are planting.
- 5. If you choose to plant in August, then July is the time to go through steps 1-3, to ensure proper prep time is given.
- 6. Grooming your Spring food plot is also essential. If you have clovers, grasses and wild life mixes, you will want to mow. Mowing has two primary advantages: First, it reduces weeds and second, it improves the food plot's productivity. Mowing before the weed's seed heads are produced, prevents weeds from spreading. Mowing also keeps the plants shorter, which deer prefer because it has less fiber, is higher in protein and more nutrients reside in the younger leaves and stems.
