<u>Bidders must use mobile bidding</u> for all items, except dessert auction items, Buy it Now, Caricatures, Sign-up Parties, Live Auction items and Fund-a-Need. (See next page for hints on using.)

Need <u>Help</u> with Mobile Bidding? Find a BID BUDDY! They should be walking around with blinking leis!

<u>Group/Split purchases</u> for Live auction items are welcome. Upon winning an item, complete the split bid sheet on your table and provide it to the Auction Runner.

During the Live Auction <u>winning bidders</u> will furnish the "floor spotters" with their bid number, name and sign the paper bid sheet upon acceptance of winning bid.

<u>Checkout</u> will open upon completion of the Live Auction. Checkout is located in the computer room to the east of the Gym.

Winners can pick up their <u>certificates</u> from checkout or items from the cafeteria upon completion of the Live Auction.

Winning bidders can **pay** with credit card on file, cash or check. Paying by check or cash reduces our cost, so please consider this option.

All attendees will receive a **paid receipt** sent to their email used upon registration or check-in.

Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be <u>used within 1 year</u> (by September 29, 2018). All arrangements must be <u>mutually agreed</u> upon between donor and buyer. Any upgrades, add-ons and changes are at the discretion of the donor.

<u>Items must be removed</u> from the venue by the end of the evening or before noon Sunday, October 1, 2017.

<u>All sales are final</u>, there can be no exchanges or refunds for items purchased. All values of items being auctioned are donors' estimates and are not warranted by Holy Trinity Catholic Church for tax purposes.

Don't forget to check with your <u>employer</u> to see if they offer a <u>matching fund program</u>. Many companies will match your donations; we are a 501(c)(3) organization.

What to Expect as a Bidder

Check-in / Registration

- 1. During check-in, you will be asked if you received a text message to take part in mobile bidding.
 - If so, you will just need to click the link!
 - o If not, you will be asked for your mobile phone number and will momentarily receive a text message.
 - If you do not receive a text message, please notify a volunteer for assistance.

Bidding - Using your Smartphone

- 1. Once logged in, your bidder number and table number (if applicable) will be displayed on the home screen.
- 2. Search for auction packages:
 - o By Number or Keyword when using the magnifying glass
 - By Category listed under the menu ≡
 - By "No Bid Packages" under the menu ≡
 - Click the house to go back to your home screen
- 3. Place a bid:
 - Quick Bid Bid the next increment.
 - Bid Let the system automatically place bids for you by using the *Max Bid* option! Bidding will automatically continue in your favor until your max bid is reached or until the auction closes. If your bid is lower than the

highest max bid on that package, you will be prompted to enter a higher bid.

- To place a straight bid, turn the Max Bid feature off and select your desired amount.
- o Buy Now If this option is enabled, you can purchase the package for the price listed.
- Watch Not ready to bid yet? Watch a package then quickly find it under My List once you are.
- 4. If you are outbid, you will be notified via text message. You will also see a notification on your home screen.

Bidding - Using a Bid Assistant

- 1. Locate a Bid Assistant.
- 2. Give the Bid Assistant your bidder number or mobile phone number; confirm the name on the screen.
- 3. Provide the number or name of the package you wish to bid on, and the amount you wish to bid.
- 4. Watch the Leaderboard or check back in with a Bid Assistant to see if you are still the highest bidder.

Making a Donation

- 1. To make a donation, select the Donation button on your home screen.
- 2. Choose a preset amount or select the Custom Amount button.

After the Auction Closes

- 1. Once the auction closes, the guest with the highest bid will win.
- 2. Go to My List to view your packages.

Things You Need to Know About Harvest

Check-in – Check-in begins at 5:00 PM. All bidders must check-in at the registration table on the west end of the cafeteria to receive a bid number. Bids will not be accepted from persons without a registered bid number. If you purchased a bid number but will not be attending, you will be contacted separately for check-in procedure.

Pick of the Live Auction Raffle – Only 100 raffle tickets will be sold for \$100 each. One of the raffle tickets will be chosen at the beginning of the live auction. If your name is drawn you pick ANY live auction item you want or \$2,000 cash! No restrictions on package choice. Purchase your ticket at registration, check-in or find the balloons and Bling Rings during Harvest! Must be present to win or have designated person to choose your item.

Premium Liquor Tasting and Souvenir Glass – Join us on a one-of-a-kind journey through the unique world of Fine Spirits. Aged Scotches, Bourbons, and Whiskeys will be available for your enjoyment. The tastings begin at 5:00 PM and end at 7:15 PM. Suggested donation is \$50.00 for a one-ounce pour of five Fine Spirits, or a single pour for \$15. Souvenir glass included. Make your donation at check-in or at the tasting table.

Caricature Artist – Don't miss your chance to have a professional caricaturist capture a fun picture of you and your friends. For a small \$10 donation, you'll have this keepsake to remember the FUN times, and funny folks! Artist is setup near the north tunnel entrance to the cafeteria and available from 5:30-8:00.

Silent Auction – All bidding (with the exception of desserts, sign-up parties and Buy-it-now) will occur via Mobile Bidding. See the Mobile Bidding section for instructions or track down a bid buddy for help. Mobile bidding for the silent auction will open on Wednesday, 9/27 at 6:00 PM.

Delicious, Delectable, Divine Desserts! – Back by popular demand! Bid on the delicious dessert you want to share with your table...or take it home for a tasty treat later. Dessert trays will be on display and available for bidding in the Silent Auction area at 5:00 PM. Bidding will close at 7:00 PM. Dessert will be delivered to the winners' tables with serving and eating utensils prior to the Live Auction. There are a limited number of dessert trays available. Be sure you and your table has a delectable dessert! All platters are yours to keep.

Buy it Now – Some items are categorized as "Buy it Now". These items are available for immediate purchase at the listed price. Find the Buy it Now display near the entrance to select an item, write your name and bid number on it and toss it in the bid box and it's yours. Any Buy it Now that you purchase will be included in your normal checkout process.

Sign-up Parties - Sign-up parties are a fun and exciting way to meet new people in the Parish and hang out with old friends. Generous hosts from the Parish plan a fun event on a set date for a certain number of individuals or couples. Individuals can then sign up to attend any sign-up party that interests them for the set price as long as there are available spots. Look for

the sign-up parties in mobile bidding prior to the Silent Auction opening and in the Silent Auction area once it opens to sign-up! See the listing in this book for additional party details.

Super Silent – You won't want to miss these select SUPER items in the Silent Auction. See the listing in this book and check out the table for all of the details!

Live Auction – The Live Auction items will be auctioned in the order in which they appear in the program. To enter a bid, the bidder must raise his/her hand or booklet high to attract the attention of the auctioneer and to be acknowledged. Each bid legally obligates the bidder to pay his/her price in full at the end of the evening if his/her bid is deemed the high bid. The auction is fast paced; bids must be made quickly! All live auction packages are valid through September 29, 2018 unless otherwise specified.

Multiple Buyers/Split Bids ~ Items with multiple buyers must be split at the time of purchase. Split bid papers are available on every table and should be filled out and provided to the Live Auction Runners at the time of purchase. Be sure to indicate to complete the bidding numbers and designated portion of the winning bid on the paper. This will help ensure efficient checkout and accurate acknowledgements.

Trips - Unless dates are specified within the description, all trips are subject to availability. Recommended booking is at least 90 days in advance. All lodging is pet-free and smoke-free with check-in after 4 pm and check-out prior to 11 am unless otherwise specified during the booking process.

Stuff the Purse - What is better than a beautiful, designer purse? A beautiful, designer purse that is stuffed with cash and other goodies! Every attendee has a chance to "stuff the purse" with a few dollars, gift cards, lotto tickets, or anything else fun that you may find in a purse or wallet. You will put your item inside our designer purse as it travels around during the silent auction and we will auction off the purse and its contents in our live auction. If you want to take home the purse and all the loot inside, make sure to be the high bidder!

Last Chance Items ~ If there are any items that have not received bids by the beginning of the Live Auction, a text will be sent out to all bidders about these available items. Don't miss an opportunity to purchase items at a great deal!

Centerpieces – Here's your chance to take a piece of Harvest home with you. All centerpieces are available for you to purchase tonight! Simply complete the purchase via Mobile Bidding or ask for help at checkout.

Games – Games add to the fun and excitement of the evening. See the games page for details on all the fun extras available this year!

Round Up – If you wish to round up your purchases, you must visit the computer room and indicate this to the person checking you out prior to the end of the event. For example, if your total is 247.00, why not make it an even 250? Or round 267 up to 300! Every dollar counts!

2017 Fund-a-Need Holy Trinity Campus-Wide Security Enhancements

The safety and wellbeing of our Holy Trinity family is something that we keep at the forefront of everything we do. We want to be open to parishioners and parents meeting and connecting in our campus spaces, but at the same time our first priority is to keep the children in our care, our students, and our staff safe whenever they are on campus.

In consultation with the Lenexa Police Department and a private security consultant we have developed a plan to enhance our campus security, especially at the Father Quigley Faith Formation Center.

Including the following:

- * Add another layer of security in the Catechesis Atrium by adding a set of security doors
- Install additional security cameras at the entrance of the Quigley Cafe and inside the Cafe
- Reinforce EEC side entrance windows
- Install one-way viewing holes and reflective film on interior EEC classroom doors and windows
- Re~key all campus outer doors
- * Number all campus outer doors to facilitate communication with first responders
- * Expand our internal radio communication system
- * Install software that allows Lenexa PD to access our campus security cameras
- Multi-phase upgrade of campus-wide card access security system




