

Ordinance 585

All ordinance appropriating certain money  
Be it ordained by the mayor and Board of com-  
missioners

Sec I That the sum of Three Hundred and Sixty Three <sup>and 89/100</sup>  
<sup>Dollars</sup> is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund  
of the City Treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said  
Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held  
on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1914 a list of which may be  
found on page 123 of the Journal of the proceedings of the  
Board on said date.

Sec II That the sum of Sixty Four <sup>and 70/100</sup> Dollars  
Be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street-  
funds of the City Treasury to pay the bills allowed  
against said <sup>Fund</sup> at a regular meeting of said Board  
held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1914 a list of which may  
be found on page 123 of the Journal of the proceedings  
of the Board on said date.

Sec III That the sum of Two Hundred and Eighty nine <sup>and 89/100</sup>  
Dollars Be and the same is hereby appropriated  
out of the Water Works Funds of the City Treasury  
to pay the bills allowed against said Fund at a  
regular meeting of said Board held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of January 1914 a list of which may be found  
on page 124 of the Journal of the proceedings of  
the Board on said date.

Sec IV That the sum of Two <sup>and 00/100</sup> Dollars  
----- Be and the same is hereby  
appropriated out of the ~~-----~~ Funds of Sewer  
District no 2 To pay the bills <sup>allowed</sup> against said  
Fund at a regular meeting of said Board  
held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1914 a list of which  
may be found on page 123 of the Journal of the  
proceedings of the Board on said date.

Sec V That the mayor and city clerk are hereby authorized <sup>and</sup>  
to draw warrants on the city treasurer to pay the bills  
allowed in sections One - Two - Three <sup>and</sup> Four of this  
Ordinance.

Sec VI That this Ordinance shall take effect and be  
in force from and after its passage by the Board  
of Commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
