Also, if showing a Bee challenge from 2020 or any of the last 2 years block of the month quilts, they also need an entry sent to Jeanna. These will not be judged by we need to make sure we have a space for them to show. Please put on top of form "Block Challenge" so it gets into the correct space.

We also need Bed turning quilts. Heirloom, antique or special. Please type up the story and send in with quilt. Lori S. is in charge of the bed turning.

We will be setting up the quilt show on Nov 3rd and will need lots of help including any of your sweet husbands, sons, or grandsons! Please sign up with Kitty.

We need to sell advertisements for the quilt show booklet. They are \$25 for a ¼ page, \$50 for a ½ page, and \$100 for a full page. We can even put your quotes or special sayings in an advertisement so please consider selling or buying one to help defray the cost of printing! Also, for every \$25 you sell your name goes into a pot for a fat quarter bundle.

Consignment quilts – there is a consignment agreement which must be completed and turned in to sell your quilts at the show. The quilts will be folded or hung on hangers. Charity quilts – A donation of 20 quilts was made to Ukraine. They were taken to Mike and Melanie in Milan, TN where they were shipped to Texas to be readied for Ukraine.

Red Bird is hoping to have a count for the quilts needed there in October. That should help us be ready. They are hoping for twin size quilts.
