



School sports funding 2015-2016

A total of £9,560 has been received for school sports funding 2015-2016, the action plan below sets out key priorities

Sports provision

- All pupils across Key Stage 2 to attend a minimum of 8 weeks swimming per year
- Embedding of new REAL PE curriculum in Foundation stage and Key Stage 1
- Qualified sports teaching PE from Reception to Year 6 weekly
- To provide our own school inter house competition half termly
- Participate in Northampton Town sports and cluster tournaments half termly
