

Rope Rescue Technician – Advanced

This is the most advanced of all of the rope rescue courses we provide. It requires a high level of technical rescue understanding, physical fitness and constant focus throughout the program.

This is not a course, but more of a workshop designed to provide the information and skills needed to pass the ITRA Rope Rescue Technician - Advanced assessment. We meet each morning for a short classroom session and then the rest of the day is spent hands on learning in dangerous and difficult terrain.

We share info such as:

- **Tower access and rescue**
- **Tree access and rescue**
- **Highlines with different reeves**
- **Pick off of suspended victim**
- **Retrievable rappels**
- **Releasable/ Contingency Anchors**
- **Passing a rigging deviation**
- **On rope line transfer**
- **Micro haul systems**
- **Night exercise**
- **Dead man anchors**
- **Guiding line offset**
- **AHDs**
- **Additional knots**

Prerequisites for this course are:

- 1. Have completed Rope Rescue Technician within 3 years of taking this course**
- 2. Hold a current 1st Responder, EMT or Wilderness First Responder certificate**
- 3. Hold a current CPR/AED card**
- 4. Pay the course payment in full**
- 5. Fill out all required paperwork on the first day of training**
- 6. Be able to work in a very high stress environment**
- 7. Be able to work in a team atmosphere**
- 8. Come prepared with all required PPE**

PPE required:

- UIAA approved helmet**
- UIAA approved harness**
- Rope rescue gloves**
- Sturdy foot wear**
- Multiple locking carabiners**
- Rappel device**
- Hand ascender(s)**
- 2 16+' tubular webbing**
- 2 prusik loops (sewn or knotted)**
- Headlamp**
- Appropriate clothing for winter weather conditions**
