





Marijuana proposal – Mr. Darren Koraleski would like the board to consider opting back in and allow a Class C license for a marijuana grow operation. His lawyer will be emailing the board some information to review. No action was taken.

Proposed Ida West Land Development – Supervisor Lucarelli spoke in regards to the possibility of changing the zoning on the approximately 67 acres owned by the township adjacent to the Pleasant View Cemetery which is currently leased for farming. By changing the zoning to Industrial, it would allow for new business in our township. The farmland lease does expire this year (2021). Motion by Strahan and supported by Lucarelli to advertise seeking sealed bids for a period of three crop seasons, with our Attorney adding a clause in the lease that there is a potential of selling a portion of the land. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

NFIRS Training – Motion by Strahan and supported by Seegert to reimburse Asst. Chief Schall for hotel, mileage and meals for two day training in Alpena next month. The class will provide training on the fire reporting system and there's no charge for the actual class. Motion carried.
