CLASSROOM: PRE-TOUR ACTIVITIES: Watch Infinity Acres Ranch Video at : www.InfinityAcres.org; Class discussion about importance of animals, (bees pollinate plants to grow our food, some animals provide meat, wool keeps us warm etc)
