

# FESTIVAL TROPHY



IFFS trophy is made by artisan who belongs to a particular community in kullu and Mandi district of Himachal Pradesh, which is called "Mohra" in local dialect. A Mohra is the material appearance of the divinity, its physical representation. It is between 8 to 12 inches in height, and 5 to 8 inches wide, made of cast metal or embossed ones begins as lumps of gold or silver beaten into thin sheets and are than shaped by repoussé technique into the face image of deities. This whole process of making a "Mohra" takes five to seven days. Mohras quite often display the upper torso, but terms such as "bust" or "mask" ill describes their morphology and function. The local term Mohra which literally translates to a face image and specific to these figures of Godess and God, is the most appropriate. Ten to fifteen Mohras are placed on palanquin that travels from village to village on the shoulders known as Devrathas or Palkis.

# VIJAY Director of Film "Thalaivi"

Vijay, is an Indian film director who works in the Tamil film industry. He debuted as director with films such as Kireedam and the critically acclaimed Madrasapattinam. Vijay later directed films such as Deiva Thirumagal and Thaandavam, starring Vikram in both films.

Thalaivii Directed by Vijay is a 2021 Indian biographical drama film based on the life of Indian actress-politician J. Jayalalithaa. The film stars Kangana Ranaut as Jayalalithaa and Arvind Swami as M. G. Ramachandran. Shot simultaneously in Tamil and Hindi, it is directed by Vijay and written by Madhan Karky (Tamil) and Rajat Arora (Hindi). Thalaivii is produced by Vishnu Vardhan Induri and Shailesh R Singh of Vibri Motion Pictures and Karma Media And Entertainment respectively. The film also features Nassar, Bhagyashree, Raj Arjun, Madhoo, Thambi Ramaiah, Sharma Kasim and Samuthirakani in supporting roles. The music, background score and the soundtrack for both languages is composed by G. V. Prakash Kumar.

The film was launched officially on Jayalalithaa's birth anniversary in 24 February 2019. Initially the film was titled Thalaivi in Tamil and Jaya in Hindi language, but the makers later planned to release it under the title Thalaivi in both languages. Principal shooting began on 10 November 2019 and completed in December 2020. The film release was postponed due to rise in COVID-19 cases and lockdown in Maharashtra. It was later rescheduled to release on 10 September 2021, with the new title Thalaivii.

Prior to directing films, Vijay was a successful advertisement filmmaker with the Mumbai-based banner Venus Productions, completing more than 100 ad films. His State Bank of India commercial won CNBC's Best Corporate Advertisement Award in 2006. In 2001, he began his career in feature films by joining Priyadarshan as an assistant director in his films.

He made his directorial debut with Kireedam in 2007, a remake of the 1989 film of the same name, directed by Sibi Malayil. Vijay then returned to work as an assistant to Suraj in his action-masala Padikathavan. Vijay's next remake of the Hindi film Khosla Ka Ghosla in Tamil, under his production house, and hence they collaborated to make Poi Solla Porom. The film also became one of the first ventures in Tamil cinema to feature a promotional song, with Vijay maintaining that the song reflected the story of the film. Vijay revealed that Madrasapattinam was supposed to happen later in his career, but the intervention of producer Kalpathi S. Aghoram of AGS Entertainment realized the viability of the film earlier. Despite being a period film, the film was finished in eight months and released in July 2010. The production of the film, Deiva Thirumagal took five months from start to finish, however, Vijay claimed that the film had been in his plans for four years, but he waited for Vikram to give him dates. Amala Paul was selected after Vijay was pleased with her award-winning work in Mynaa. Vijay directed the Harris: On The Edge concerts by music composer Harris Jayaraj.

In 2013, he worked with Vijay alongside Amala Paul for the movie Thalaivaa. In February 2016, he was named as a director of Prabhu Deva's trilingual film Devi opposite Tamannaah which was made in Tamil, Telugu and Hindi. This marked his debut in Telugu and Hindi languages.

# **JURY**



SHRINIVAS JOSHI

Shri Shriniwas Joshi is a resident of Panchwati at Shimla. He superannuated from the IAS, Himachal Cadre. He is a keen dramatist and so has interest in films too. He has directed and acted in about 30 plays on stage and more than 150 radio-plays. During his tenure as Director of Language and Culture Department, he conceived and edited three documentary films-Himachal Pradesh ke Loknritya, Kangra ke Devsthal and Kamniya Kinnaur. After retirement, he worked as father of Nainsukh, the known miniature painting artist of Himachal Pradesh, in the art-film 'Nainsukh' directed by Shri Amit Dutta. The film won several awards in India and foreign countries. Shri Joshi also acted in a film based on Ram Kumar, the known artist of India, again directed by Shri Amit Dutta.



PAMPALLY

Pampally, was the recipient of two prestigious awards at the 65th National Film Awards ceremony, which honoured the best films of 2018. His film, *Sinjar*; bagged both the Indira Gandhi Award for the Best Debut Film and the Best Feature Film in the Jasari language. Pampally became a JURY MEMBER of the 67<sup>th</sup> National Film Awards and an Oscar Jury member for foreign language in 2021, organised by the Film Federation of India. In 2020, Pampally became the JURY of NIFFFI (Nila International Folklore Film Festival of India), and in 2019, he became the JURY CHAIRMAN for the LENS FLARE AWARDS. Pampally won more than 35 International Film Awards as director and for his best work. Being a writer, he has published four short storey collections and won four major literature state awards for his writing.



Dr SARVCHETAN KATOCH

Dr Sarvchetan Katoch is Associate Professor of English at Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, University of Delhi. His academic interest includes Modern Indian Literature, Literature of the Indian diasphora, literary theory, film and cultural studies and translation studies. He has published a number of scholarly articles on Indian Literature and Cinema in various academic journals and edited volumes. His book published on cinema titled 'The Spinning Reel: Reclaiming Swaraj through Rachnatmak Hindi cinema''




ARIJIT KUNDU

Both Jaunsar Bavar and Trans-Giri areas used to be part of the royal former Sirmaur state until the separation of Jaunsar Bawar in 1815.


## MANORANJAN BADATYA
