Subject: GLUCAGON

ACTION:

Causes breakdown of glycogen to glucose.

Inhibits glycogen synthesis.

Elevates blood glucose level.

Positive Inotrope.

Positive Chronotrope

INDICATIONS:

Hypoglycemia

Beta Blocker Overdose

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Hypersensitivity to the drug.

PRECAUTIONS:

Only effective if there are sufficient stores of glycogen within the liver.

Use with caution in patients with cardiovascular or renal disease.

Draw blood glucose prior to administration.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Few in emergency situations

DOSAGE:

Hypoglycemia: 1 unit may repeat in 10-20 minutes if no response.

Beta Blocker Overdose: 3-10 units IV over 1 minute. May be followed by an infusion of 2-5 units/hr.

Note: 1 unit = 1 mg

ROUTE:

IV

IM

PEDIATRIC DOSE:

Rarely used.
