Trustees' Report.....

Although the Trustees took a break from meeting in July, there were still lots of things happening. We are finally headed down the home stretch on the church renovations! The new stair treads and tile are installed at the entrance from Center Street. The kitchen is almost complete. There are a few more electrical outlets which need installed. After that it will need a thorough cleaning prior to the required inspection.

In the Parish House, the installation of the air conditioning system couldn't have come at a better time! The finishing of what will be Pastor Bill's office had a setback last month as the workers noticed the floors they had jacked up earlier were settling again. After some more shoring up from the basement below, work continued on the office. The drywall is hung and the finishing work should begin soon. We are anxiously awaiting the installation of the new front door and the new doors for the stairway and the new restroom.

Thanks to lots of prayers, careful planning, and a great team effort, the transition of the parsonage occupants from Pastor Damien to Pastor Bill and Janet went fairly smoothly. The time in between the moves allowed for the interior and exterior of the house to be painted and the house was thoroughly cleaned (including the interior of the ducts). The only item that wasn't purchased and installed prior to the McNeal's arrival was a new refrigerator, which has been taken care of since. All things considered, it was a relatively smooth transition. The Trustees hope the McNeals are settling in well, and feeling 'at home' in their new home.

Lay Leader's Report

I conducted the full Traditional worship service at Bethany on Sunday, June 25, as Pastor Damien worked to complete his transition from Milton to Towanda. The sermon at that night's Contemporary service was more than ably delivered by Dave Gehrum of Watsontown UMC. (Our good friend Dave has become our "evening guest speaker" of choice because of the effectiveness and memorable nature of his unique messages.) On a related note, I've agreed to substitute for Pastor Bill to conduct our Traditional services when he takes vacation days on the Sundays of August 6 and August 20, and Dave has been asked to speak at both (or at least one) of those two Contemporaries.

The Crossroads of Life Prison Faith Community in central Illinois reports that they have received the second of the two shipments of basic toiletries kits that I sponsored earlier this year. Those are all going to the Logan Correctional Center for Women in Lincoln, IL in response to the pressing need for personal care necessities for new prison arrivals. I plan to approach Crossroads again soon to find out if that program could use more support to come behind the first groups of kits and to check on their supply of Bibles for the prison.

I'd like to report some happy news on behalf of all of the staff and volunteer workers at Bethany who use the Parish House offices. We are now in our renovated quarters, and we have air conditioning. Praise be on both counts, and even though work continues in that area – both by construction teams and in terms of our own adjustments - we're already so much better off in terms of space and comfort as to heighten our efficiencies and gladden our hearts to unprecedented levels.
