Ad Hoc:

RV Park Proposal Committee: Mike presented the information collected and decided by the committee. Reported that the committee has met to create an action plan and some steps have already been taken. Noted that it's clear we don't know what will come of the next meeting, but we are working to be prepared. We are aiming to gather letters of opposition as well as an online petition. The point being we don't want to get quiet about it.

The current biggest problem: This is going to cost money, and we don't have money to do that currently. The challenge is how to raise money. There are several barriers that make raising funds difficult.

Mike made a proposal to allocate \$5,000 from the Lake q fund to the Special Event fund to pay for activities. \*Full proposal is located in MMP in October Special Meeting folder.\*

Historical knowledge question about Ice Mountain proceedings from Bruce. Sandy answered.

Mike suggested it would be best, before voting to allocate funds, to have a roll call vote from each board member as their position (In Favor or Opposed) regarding the RV Park Proposal.

Mike then made the above motion, Craig 2<sup>nd</sup>, Motion Passed.

Roll Call Results: Unanimously Opposed

Sandy added the justification that the lake quality fund should be where these funds come from due to the negative impact the RV park will have on our lakes and surrounding areas. Discussion on what the impact our position and allocation of funds might have regarding our donors. Many comments about balance and holistic approach. Agreement that the committee is truly trying to take a proactive approach.
