<u>Financial statement</u> The May 2012 financial statement was presented.

<u>Lake/Snow report</u> The lake has 916 AF in storage. The snow – water equivalent is at 0 percent of average and the ytd precipitation is at 56 percent of average. Soil moisture is at 3 percent saturation. A mandatory 60% restriction is in effect. Meters will be read monthly and communications with customers will continue.

<u>Committee report</u> The water and sewer committee met last week to discuss the agenda and irrigation restrictions.

<u>Items from staff</u> At present consumption levels; Mark projects the lake to remain on until the 21st of August. Many factors could influence the date and Mark described it as "a moving target". The Upper Schumaker well rehabilitation is in progress. The pump is pulled. The casing was videoed and the contractor is scheduled to begin cleaning and brushing the casing Friday. Mark asked the board if they had any objections to cancelling the regularly scheduled meeting of July 5th. There were no objections.
