

It is with this confidence in our bulls that we can give our full 90-day breeding season guarantee. We understand that these are animals and that injuries do occur, but we have the utmost confidence that we have developed these bulls in the best way to protect your investment. If an injury or death occurs, Strommen Ranch will guarantee them for the purchase price minus salvage value (\$1,500), or we will provide a replacement bull, if a suitable bull is available.

We don't make you take out an insurance policy and add that to the purchase price. We don't have a formula to take away half of the value of the bull if injury occurs. At the same time, these are not 'disposable' bulls. 




