

## "A Significant 1700th Anniversary for Us Christians"

*"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."* John 3.16

Seventeen hundred years ago this spring and summer Christians from the known civilized world had a significant meeting that solidified the basic understanding of Jesus which has stood the test of time in the centuries since then. One of the first things that early church leaders had to do in terms of biblical understanding was to figure out who Jesus was and is. In the first couple of centuries there was a struggle to figure out who Jesus was and is. Some questioned whether He was fully God. Some questioned whether He was fully human. A few thought that God took three forms: Sometimes He appeared as God the Father, sometimes as God the Son, sometimes as God the Holy Spirit.

In the early 300s AD the bishop of Alexandria Egypt, who was named Alexander, was dealing with a pastor in his area named Arius who questioned the full deity of Jesus. He argued that the Son of God had a beginning. He was subordinate to the Father. He was also capable of change, alternating between good and evil. Arius was a dynamic speaker, and his views took root in other parts of the Empire, leading to riots in several cities.

In 312 AD the Roman Emperor Constantine had a dramatic conversion. The next year he made Christianity a legal religion. He discovered the disputes going on among Christians and called for a conference of church leaders at his summer palace in Nicea in what is today Turkey. One early leader says that the conference convened on May 20, 325. It was to continue through July. Between 250 and 300 bishops showed up along with over a thousand other assistants.

The conference quickly recognized the heresies of Arius. Part of the problem was his misunderstanding of the original Greek word in John 3:16 often translated as "only begotten." All but two of the bishops agreed that Jesus Christ was fully God as well as fully man. Arius and those two bishops were exiled. The conference also adopted what has become known to us as the Nicene Creed.

The first part of the creed reads like this: "We believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, begotten from the Father before all ages, God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten, not made; of the same essence as the Father. Through him all things were made."

The Council also adopted some basic rules for church leaders, and it set a date for Easter, which calculation is still used by most of the Christian church today. It would be left to later conferences to hammer out an understanding of the Holy Spirit and of salvation and of the church. But the Nicene Creed has been accepted as an orthodox statement of faith by most all Christian groups. 
### Joy for our Journey
