

William S. Horn Dies Tuesday

Funeral services were scheduled for Thursday afternoon, June 10, at 2. p. m. for William S. Horn, 75, who passed away Tuesday morning at Schilling Nursing home, Pigeon, after an illness of five years.

Chapel services were scheduled for Shetler Funeral home and church services in Hayes Methodist church, with the Rev. Mr. Ferris Woodruff officiating. Burial was in the Caseville cemetery.
