Dale reported he and Bill had attended the CIB C.I.B. GRANT meeting, and our application has been tabled until November HEARING 3, 1988. Various aspects of loan vs. grant or a combination were discussed. Dan suggested the District hire the title company to research the high water right to find out who owns it. If the District could buy those rights, we will have more water to sell. This was discussed. Dutch moved we get a bid to have this research done. Dan seconded. MOTION CARRIED. Dan suggested Phyllis Cortes might be contacted to do this research.

The Resolution for Deferred Compensation Plan wasRESOLUTION tabled pending the answer from Bretzke.

Dale reported that he, Kedrick Somerville and M.I.C. DAM Deloy Lance had looked at the leaking M.I.C. Dam and the AND DELIVERY delivery points which require measuring devices. Kedrick POINT MEASURWILL be back Wednesday with their engineer to look at these ING DEVICES problems and SCS will make their recommendations afterward.

The September financial statement was handed to ${\tt FINANCIAL}$ those present, and Dale stated the budget will have to be ${\tt STATEMENT}$ amended to bring the line items into balance.

Dale reported the lake is still dropping, and the $_{\rm KEN'S\ LAKE}$ water will probably be shut down the first of next week. $_{\rm LEVEL}$ When he shuts down the line, he will stake the edge of the water to see if there is further surface drop after the system is shut down.
