Information for Gymnasts, Families and Fans!

The competition is held at the Branson Convention Center (200 South Sycamore Street).

Parking: Unfortunately, the Branson Convention Center has begun charging for parking. \$7/24 hour cycle. Credit/debit card payment is accepted. NO Cash!

GYMNAST CHECK IN: Gymnast check in is available prior to your gymnast's session so that you may take advantage of free/discount coupons for attractions or restaurants. *Gymnasts who have checked in early – or perhaps running late to general stretch – simply report to their coach in the competition arena. **T-SHIRTS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE COACHES AT EACH SESSION.***

ADMISSION FEE: \$10/day – 12 yrs and older; \$5/day – 6-12 yrs; Children 5 and under – Free. (Cash only, CC not accepted).

Rotation/score sheets are complementary. Please note that the gymnasts are placed in order by their coach each rotation so the standard rotation sheets are not applicable. The rotation sheet will only show what Flight and Squad your gym begins. Should your team be split into more than one squad in a session, please look for your individual gymnast during March In to see which event she is placed.

All Sessions are Modified Capitol format: Two (2) sets of equipment sharing one floor – “Flight A” and “Flight B”. Immediately after March-In, Flight A will begin warming up their first event. As soon as these gymnasts begin competing, athletes in Flight B will begin warming up their first event. Once competition begins, there will be continuous rotation from one event to another.

Awards will follow each session. Award groups are based on the number of gymnasts per level – no more than 14 in an age group. 50% events; 100% All Around; 50% Team. Once each session begins, any needed adjustments in age groups will be made due to any scratches of athletes to fairly distribute award groups. Should you have a question, please notify your coach.

Please remember: there is NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY allowed upon completion of March In announcements. This is for the safety of all athletes!

PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY ON THE ESCALATORS AT ANY TIME! Only athletes, coaches, assigned volunteers, staff and judges are allowed beyond the stanchions.

Outside food or beverages are not allowed in the Convention Center. A concession stand is located in the competition area for your convenience.

Looking for a great photo of your gymnast? P-R Photos will be taking pictures of all gymnasts on beam and floor. *Should you wish your gymnast NOT be photographed, please notify the P-R Photos booth prior to that session.*
