ORDINANCE NO. 360

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, MISSOURI TO MODIFY ORDINANCE NO. 291 TO CHANGE THE BUSINESS PERMIT PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the Village of Innsbrook (the "Village") has adopted Ordinance No. 291 which established regulations for the issuance of business permits.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desired to establish a business permit, application, and associated regulations to promote the welfare of the Village by ensuring consistent standards are applied to all businesses: and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to enact this Ordinance so that all current and future businesses are operating with the Village's knowledge and in compliance with State law so that the Village may adequately protect the safety and welfare of the Village.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that the change to the business permit period is in the best interest of the business owners and the Village. The Village will change the business permit period from July 1 through June 30 to January 1 through December 31. In doing this change, the Village's permits will match the Innsbrook Owners' Association permit period. The Innsbrook Owners' Association will include the renewal information for the Village in their renewal packet. The Innsbrook Owners' Association requires that the businesses obtain the Village of Innsbrook's permit first before they will proceed.

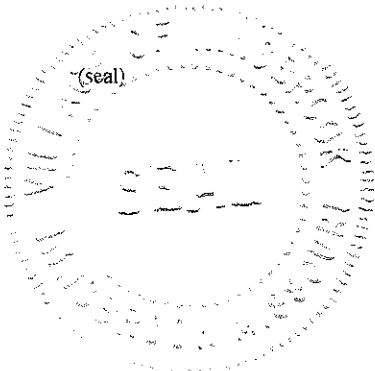
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

PERMIT YEAR

Unless otherwise provided, shall mean the year beginning January 1 or, in the case of businesses newly established, at the beginning of doing business and ending on the following December 31.

Section II: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect both from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Chairman and Board of Trustees.

Said Bill was passed and approved this 15th day of April, 2025, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two times prior to passage.
