KENNETH W. ENSCOE SHEET METAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM RULES

1. Graduating high school seniors or current full-time college students who are children of an SMWIA Local 12 member, an employee of a signatory contractor, or an employee of the Association, shall be eligible to apply for and receive scholarships. The amount available for the scholarships shall be determined annually by the Board of Directors. The amounts of individual scholarships shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee each year.
2. Scholarship awards are competitive and shall be based on:
 - a. Academic standing of the student during their academic career, including high school and any college completed to date
 - b. A recent college entrance examination board score, if applicable
 - c. Extracurricular, work and volunteer activities and leadership
 - d. A written essay, the subject of which shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee
3. Applicants shall submit a complete application postmarked or emailed by the deadline to receive consideration for scholarships. Any incomplete applications will not be reviewed by the Committee.
4. The Scholarship Committee shall rank the candidates to determine the winner(s). If, for any reason, a scholarship winner becomes ineligible to accept the award, the Committee may choose to review the applications of non-winners and select a new recipient.
5. A scholarship winner may attend any accredited college or university within the United States but must be enrolled full-time.
6. The award shall not be forfeited if the applicant's parents or guardian become inactive in the industry after the award is granted.
7. If a recipient enters military service, they shall be eligible to receive the full amount of the award when he or she is able to attend school on a full-time basis.
8. The awards will be made payable to the college or university of the recipient's choice, and will be mailed to the recipient's home address, after providing proof of acceptance for admission.
9. Any change in the education status of the scholarship recipient must be immediately reported to the office of SMACNA of Western Pennsylvania by the recipient.
10. The scholarship awards being provided by SMACNA of Western Pennsylvania can only be offered and awarded as long as there is an Industry Fund.
11. SMACNA's Board of Directors reserves the right to revise, change or cancel the scholarship awards program at their discretion.
