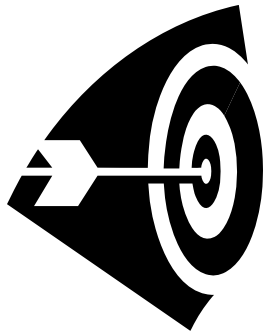


Halt 1 2!
