- 4. REVIEW PROPOSED SLO COUNTY CANNABIS ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS**

Review and approve TAAG recommendations regarding proposed SLO County cannabis ordinance amendments ordinance Title 22 Chapter 22.40 –

Cannabis Activities for submission to the SLO County Board of Supervisors (BOS) who will be considering certain proposed County cannabis ordinance amendments at its scheduled October 6, 2020 Board hearing. TAAG's Cannabis Project Review Committee held a publicly noticed September 24, 2020 Committee meeting and voted 3 – 0 to submit the Committee's recommendations to the TAAG full Board for review and approval.

The Board of Supervisors first heard this matter on August 18, 2020. Eight proposed amendments were considered but NOT approved due to a 2 -2 tie vote by the four member Supervisor Board. However, an edited "redlined" 53-page draft comprised of approximately 100 proposed amendments, published by the County Planning Department for public review and comments was submitted by County Planning for consideration by the Supervisors. Only 8 proposed amendment items were individually voted all on August 18th. Action on all additional proposed amendments presented on the 53-page edited Chapter 22.40 ordinance draft was put off and scheduled for the October 6th BOS Hearing. The complete 53-page "redlined" copy of this edited 53-page proposed draft of County cannabis ordinance Title 22 Chapter 22.40's 53-page proposal can be viewed at the following weblink. All indicated "redlined" items in the draft are considered proposed ordinance amendments.

The TAAG CPRC Committee was provided with a draft recommendation report by the Committee Chair Murray Powell during its September 24th Committee meeting. This report (attached) lists approximately fifty-five (55) proposed amendments in the 53-page Title 22 Chapter 22.40 Cannabis ordinance draft that should be considered during the BOS October 6th hearing. This list identifies each item by County ordinance section designation that should be reviewed and individually voted on by the Board of Supervisors during their October 6, 2020 hearing on this matter.

TAAG Bylaws require that the TAAG Board meet monthly on the third Thursday of each month. The regular October regular TAAG meeting is currently scheduled for the evening of October 15, 2020. Zoom Instructions are presented at the beginning of this Notice. It is important that all participants conduct themselves with courtesy, dignity, civility, and respect for all parties involved. If you wish to present oral or written comments, please observe the following guidelines:

1. The meeting will be held remotely through Zoom teleconferencing due to the State restrictions that prevent the conduct of public meetings and hearings with the public in physical attendance within hearing rooms.

2. Please clearly identify yourself **each time you speak during a Zoom teleconference.**
3. Identify yourself by your full name (and representation, if any) for our minutes, and speak so other attendees will have the opportunity to listen to the comments.
4. Address your comments to the Chair. Conversation or debate between a speaker and a member of the audience is not permitted. Every member of the public will be allowed to speak.
5. Oral comments should be brief and to the point. Your comments should be about issues, and not about any individuals involved. Please do not interrupt a speaker during that person's comments.
6. Public oral comment is generally limited to three minutes per individual unless the Chair permits otherwise.
7. Please -- no audience reaction during or after comments.
8. Written comments (letter, e-mail, etc.) are acceptable, but should be distributed to TAAG at least two days before the meeting. Written comments will be read during the public comment hearing period.
9. Once the public comment portion of the meeting is closed, there will be no further public oral comments unless requested of and permitted by the Chair.
