

Suspended Borrowers Policy

The use of the library may be denied for due cause. Such cause may be failure to return materials or pay fees, destruction of library property, disturbance of other patrons, or other objectionable or illegal conduct on library premises.

In lieu of payment for lost items, patron's aged 12 and over may volunteer at the library, with the permission of the Director. The patron's fee will be reduced by \$1.00 for every hour of volunteer work.

Patrons with a history of keeping materials beyond their due dates may have their privileges restricted or suspended. Additionally, patrons who repeatedly return audiovisual materials in the outside drop box rather than bringing them inside, may have their borrowing privileges for audiovisual items suspended. An oral warning will be given for the first two instances before privileges are restricted or suspended at the third instance and a notation placed on the patron's account.
