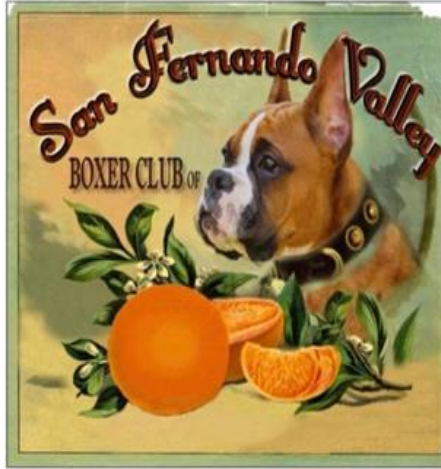

NATIONAL OWNER HANDLER SERIES

The Club will hold NOHS events at both Friday & Saturday Specialties.

Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** competition.

Online entrants – Please select Yes in the Owner Handler Eligible field, check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write 'NOHS' in the Additional Classes box.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

FOUR TO SIX MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION

Entry fee \$20.00 – Friday only.

Entry can be made using the regular AKC Entry Form. Please designate "4-6 Month" in the Dog Show Class box. The AKC Litter Registration number can be used. The 4-6 Month Puppy Class will NOT be divided by sex. A Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex will be selected from the entrants in the class.

Please Note: Per AKC Rules, Professional Handlers and their assistants may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" and will not compete for awards. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or their assistants may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Minors under 18 with amateur status who reside with professional handlers or their assistants may personally exhibit dogs and compete for awards in this competition.

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry Fee \$25.00 – Friday only.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Boxers who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. All puppy entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Breed Class.

No Champions of Record

Same Classes for dogs and bitches

Puppy, 6 – 9 mos. Puppy, 9 – 12 mos. Junior, 12 – 18 mos.

The BEST PUPPY shall compete against the BEST JUNIOR, and the winner shall be designated GRAND SWEEPSTAKES WINNER.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Boxers, 6 years of age and older on the day of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.**

Same Classes for dogs and bitches

Veterans, 6 to 8 years (Junior) Veterans, 8 Years & over (Senior)

The BEST JUNIOR IN VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES winner will compete against the BEST SENIOR IN SWEEPSTAKES winner for GRAND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES WINNER.

The Club shall retain 35% of the total receipts for expenses. The remainder shall be divided as follows:

OWNERS of the 1st place winners of each class – 60% of Class stakes
OWNER of BEST PUPPY in PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES - 40% of Division stakes
OWNER of BEST JUNIOR in PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES - 40% of Division stakes
OWNER of BEST JUNIOR in VETERAN SWEEPS - 40% of Division stakes
OWNER of BEST SENIOR in VETERAN SWEEPS - 40% of Division stakes

Novice Open Master

Novice Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have not won 3 first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have won 3 first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have won 10 first place awards in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition.

Notice: Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present may transfer their entry into the Open Class provided that the transfer is made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

*The Dolores Caprino Memorial Trophy (gold-toned trophy on wood base) is offered by the Boxer Club of San Fernando Valley for Best of Breed at its Specialty Shows. The date and name of the winning dog and owner will be suitably engraved on the trophy each year. The trophy will remain in the custody of the Boxer Club of San Fernando Valley

Best in Puppy Classes: The First-Place winners of each of the four puppy classes (6-9 Mos & 9-12 Mos - **NOT** Bred by Puppy) will compete for Best in Puppy Classes at the Friday show.

Best in Bred by Exhibitor Classes: The First-Place winners of the four Bred by Exhibitor Classes (Bred by Puppy & Adult) will compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor at the Saturday show.

AWARD OF MERIT

At the Judge's discretion, Award(s) of Merit will be awarded to Boxers who are in serious competition for Best of Breed awards. It shall be entirely the judge's decision to award all, some, or none. Awards of Merit shall be awarded to dogs and bitches other than the Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, and Grand Champion Select winners.

The AOM criteria is as follows:

6-9 Champions – 1 AOM

10-13 Champions – 2 AOM

14+ Champions – 3 AOM

**ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES MUST BE IN THE OFFICE OF THE SHOW
SECRETARY NOT LATER THAN**

12:00 NOON MST – WEDNESDAY – MAY 14, 2025

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned and telegraphed entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show rules.

THIS SHOW is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS will be e-mailed to all entrants who provide email addresses. All others will be mailed by the USPS.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.

THE BCOSFV may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Clubs, the Lake Perris State Recreation Area or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it becomes impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

THE CLUBS, THEIR SHOW SECRETARY and THE VENTURA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS will not be responsible for the loss of or injury to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. And, in addition, no responsibility will be assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an owner, exhibitor, handler or spectator. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog. TROPHIES AND CLASS CASH PRIZES will be awarded in the judging ring to the person showing the dog. In the event of any discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Chairman should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2)

TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the Show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.
