Corn, Wanda M. ***Georgia O'Keeffe: Living Modern.*** Prestel: 2017. Lavish museum exhibition catalog about how O'Keeffe used a modernist style not only in her art but also in her clothes, her homes and her lifestyle. Fascinating and delightful.

Drohojowska-Philp, Hunter. ***Full Bloom: The Art and Life of Georgia O'Keeffe.*** W.W. Norton: 2005. Painstakingly detailed biography, over 500 pages. Delves more into O'Keeffe's art than other biographies; author is an art journalist and an artist herself. Well-written. The biography I'd recommend for someone who is an artist.

Robinson, Roxana. ***Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life.*** UPNE: 1999. Exhaustively researched biography, the first written with her family's cooperation. Author is a novelist and her writing is lively and very readable though it sometimes veers into speculation.

O'Keeffe, Georgia. ***Georgia O'Keeffe.*** Viking: 1974. Glossy, oversized book packed with stunning images of her art, compiled by O'Keeffe herself and with her own commentary running alongside. Not a full autobiography. Essential for O'Keeffe enthusiasts.

Lisle, Laurie. ***Portrait of an Artist: A Biography of Georgia O'Keeffe.*** 1980. Repr., Washington Square Press: 1997. Fascinating, very readable biography. The first comprehensive biography of O'Keeffe and my favorite of the O'Keeffe biographies.

Rodriguez, Rachel Victoria, and Julie Paschkis. ***Through Georgia's Eyes.*** Henry Holt: 2006. A short picture book using cut-paper collages to tell O'Keeffe's story in an approachable, inspiring way for very young readers.

Venezia, Mike. ***Georgia O'Keeffe (Getting to Know the World's Greatest Artists).*** Children's Press: 1993. Delightful children's book. Includes real artwork images, humorous cartoons and an approachable biography geared for children aged 8-12.
