Frank Klebba, 85, of Harbor Beach, passed away Thursday morning, May 12, 2005, in Harbor Beach Community Hospital's Long Term Care Unit. Born on August 20, 1919 in Ruth, he was the son of the late Julius and Frances (Makowski) Klebba.
