## Prepare for Extreme Winter Weather

### EMERGENCY SUPPLIES to have on hand:

- **WATER METER KEY** to access your meter box if necessary



- **INSULATION** for indoor and outdoor pipes



- **HOSE BIB COVERS** for outdoor faucets



- Battery powered **RADIO** and **FLASHLIGHT**



- Have enough water for **1 GALLON PER PERSON PER DAY FOR 7 DAYS**



As we enter what is usually the coldest months in Austin, it is time to make sure you're prepared for potential wintry weather.

Follow the 4 P's for winter weather safety:

- *People* – Before going outside, dress in layers to protect yourself from the cold. While heating your home, do not use a generator, grill, camp-stove, or any gasoline, propane, or charcoal-burning device because they generate deadly carbon monoxide gas.
- *Pets* – Bring your pets inside to keep them warm and safe.
- *Pipes* – Insulate or cover exposed pipes to protect them from freezing, turn off outside faucets, drip ONE faucet only, if needed.
- *Plants* – Cover your plants or bring them in.
