The address is 2544 Executive Drive, Indianapolis, IN 46241 and shuttle service is available from the airport. You will need to reserve your room by contacting the hotel directly, by calling 317-248-2481. You must let them know you are a member of the Great Lakes Shrine Association Legions of Honor to receive the discounted rate. Reservations must be made with the hotel by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.
