Dear Governor Cuomo Office, Greetings to you;

I PAULETT ANGELLA HEMMINGS EARTH, CHREATOR OF THESE EARTHS AND THE ONLY CHREATOR OVER ALL CHREATIONS. I AM THE CHREATOR OF LIFE AND OVER ALL LIFE, DEATH, ESISTENCE, AND ANYTHING INBETWEEN DECLARE IN THIS CONGESSARUM THAT:

WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT all across this Earth, these Earths, and Chreations, July 8, 2017 the work hours have changed. Below are the New Work Hours on Shifts:

This entire Earth are now back to the 8 days per week. The day after Friday, is Bensasday. Bensasday is a day you can use prepare your essence and your meals for about a week. It is a flexible day. It will never be used to increase the work week to 6 days per week.

We will now use 36 days per month equally beginning November 1, 2017/2018.

The work week is now flexible with consecutive work days. Every employee (worker) chooses which shift to work and stay on that shift. The shift can be morning, afternoon, or night shift. A shift can be changed after one year if the worker chooses. For major events in one' life, or severe dislike, an employee can change his or her shift within six months of shift change, or based on the urgency. There is no daily, weekly or monthly shift changes.

If an employer asks a worker to change his or her shift, and the worker agrees, the worker must get a shift change allowance added to their pay and no less than 10 percent of their current salary (pay). The shift change must be workable for the employee and not cause any problems to the worker life or schedule.

No one needs to rush to work. You work no more than five (5) hours per day. You work no more than four (4) days per week. The total hours for full time employment is between twelve to sixteen (12 to 16) hours per week. No one needs to work over 16 hours per week. For night shift workers like those who work in the hospitals, hotels, customer service, and so on, they get double time pay. Your reason to be in this Earth is to protect yourself and enjoy your life.

A work week can be three consecutive days.

If an employee's work hours is short during a work week, it can be made up the following week or negotiated with your supervisor or leader.

You work to develop your mind and thinking at your pace, and you do not work to be pressured, oppressed, overworked, suppressed, bullied, or harassed.

Some workers like the Nurses who work in Home care, hotels, and others who work in places where the transportation is not efficient, and also those who work at night, they may work beyond the five hours per day. In those cases, once their work is beyond the five hours, they get two and a half $(2 \frac{1}{2})$ times pay.

Some workers who are administrative, and they have to prepare presentations, graphics, set up events, and other similar work, and they have deadlines to meet, in those cases they get 2.5 times pay for every minute of work over the five hours. They also get a team of assistants who know the job, so the work is coordinated and reduces the pressure to meet the deadline.

Part time workers get their full benefits (body fitness/health care, retirement, union, insurance benefits, bonuses, and so on) which would be half of what the full-time worker are getting. All hourly workers are part-time workers.
