Reservations:

- Reservations are highly recommended. To make a reservation call 573-637-2290.
- <u>Weekday reservations</u>: To reserve a primitive campsite there is a \$12 deposit per campsite required at the time of booking. That deposit will be credited toward camping fees upon arrival. To reserve an electrical site, the electric fees must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- <u>Weekend Reservations</u>: A 2 night minimum is required on all sites. To reserve a primitive campsite there is a \$24 deposit required at the time of booking. That deposit will be credited toward camping fees upon arrival. To reserve an electrical site, the electric fees must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- We accept Visa, MasterCard & Discover. Credit and Debit transactions of less than \$5 are not permitted.
- All prices are subject to change.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

- <u>Primitive campsites:</u> The deposit is non-refundable.
- <u>RV or tent electric sites</u>: Reservations cancelled 7 days prior to arrival date will be refunded in full, minus a \$15 cancellation fee. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR CANCELATIONS MADE WITHIN 7 DAYS OF THE RESERVATION DATE.

Raincheck Policy

There are no refunds or rainchecks issued for camping due to inclement weather.

The Campground Rules

- No entry permitted into the campground after Midnight on Fridays and Saturday nights.
- No entry permitted into the campground after 10pm, Monday-Thursday nights.
- We are a family style campground. <u>Our midnight quiet hour is strictly</u> <u>enforced.</u> Radios must be turned down at 10 pm and OFF at midnight. No loud noises after quiet hours. If we have to ask you to leave, you will NOT receive a refund.
- Absolutely no glass is permitted in campground. Plastics and cans only!
- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. No aggressive animals will be allowed. You will be held accountable for your pet's actions.
- No drugs, guns or contraband or other illegal activities will be tolerated. We cooperate fully with the Sheriff's department to prosecute illegal activity.
- We will assess a \$50 fine to those that damage trees. Firewood is sold at the office.
- Absolutely no vehicles are allowed in the Black River.
- We do not permit ATVs, dirt bikes or loud vehicles. However, we do permit side by sides and golf carts during daylight hours.
- Fireworks are not permitted.
- Camping passes expire at 4 pm on your day of departure. If you are floating that day, please pack up your camp site before your float. Vehicles can be parked at the office.
