Marching Season Fees will be determined later this school year and are generally about \$250 per member. Marching jackets, gloves and shoes will also need to be purchased. These items will be ordered during the summer.

Two teacher recommendations, parent commitment/permission signature forms and a final recommendation by the middle school band director are also required. All requirements must be submitted by May 2, 2025.
